

# **Annual report 2016**

**Mundito is ten years old.** It started with a trial balloon in fall 2006. Founders Margaret Graff and Richard Higgins asked friends if they would like to help build a modest medical center in rural Guatemala with Plan International. By our friends' generous response, we knew there was great work that we could do

together. We launched Mundito Foundation, a 501(c)(3) private foundation, in early 2007. We remain a group of friends and friends-of-friends who together accomplish great things.

- Since our launch, you've helped us provide grants of almost \$516k to worthy nonprofits. Of this amount, \$278k came from the generous donors who are Team Mundito.
- We have completed 20 campaigns, nine supporting work around Atlanta, one national, and ten international (two each in Guatemala, Nepal, and India; Burkina Faso, Nicaragua, Ghana, and now South Sudan).
- We estimate that approximately 8,800 people have benefitted from our work. We have saved lives in South Sudan, freed slaves in Nepal and Ghana, given an education boost to underserved populations in the US, Nicaragua, and Burkina Faso, and impacted thousands of in many other ways.

**Our Mission: Mundito Foundation** seeks to change lives of individuals who live with inadequate resources, public health care, or education. Mundito serves as a "giving group", undertaking projects with partner nonprofit organizations that meet our objectives: **Specific. Efficient. Changing lives.** 

### Our donors love Mundito because...

- Three board members who help find and design projects, provide due diligence, and help spread the good word about how you can change lives,
- A small army of extraordinary donors (aka Team Mundito) who dig deep to help us solve some of the world's problems.
- A 501(c)(3) private foundation. All donations are tax-deductible.

That's it. No employees. Minimal expenses (mostly tax filing and audit) are covered by the founders. We strive for staggering efficiency and we hope you agree that we achieved this again in 2016.

## Projects funded in 2015:



**Rebuilding, Nepal, Fall 2015:** We completed a project with our friends at Plan International to rebuild a school that was destroyed in the Nepal earthquake of 2015. Our target grant was \$44k, but thanks to the generosity of Team Mundito we were able to make a supplementary grant of \$6,000 in 2016.

Resiliency, Atlanta, Spring 2016: We worked with Community Advanced Practice Nurses to launch a series of workshops to teach coping skills to professionals who work with the homeless. Our target grant was \$32k, but Team Mundito's enthusiastic response allowed a supplementary grant of \$1,000.


Hunger Crisis, Nepal, Fall 2016: The global hunger experts at Action Against Hunger proposed that we feed people in dire need in South Sudan. For \$50k we were able to nourish 2,500 people (mostly children ages five and under) for three months, helping many of them turn the corner and survive the famine that now grips South Sudan. We anticipate making a supplementary grant in early 2017, again thanks to the generosity of Team Mundito.

#### **Growth:**

"Thanks for all you do. It's amazing. Glad to play our little part." Mundito has enjoyed healthy growth over the past few years. Our donors' enthusiasm derives from their trust that a Mundito project will put their money to work efficiently and effectively. Average donations, \$349 per donor per campaign in 2016, continue to rise.

The chart below shows the yearly growth of donations to Mundito by campaign. The international campaign attracts somewhat larger amounts (upper curve), as many donors feel a US dollar goes further in a developing country. Domestic campaigns (lower curve) are important to many donors who prefer to give locally. (As of 12/31/16, the 2016 international campaign was still actively collecting donations, so the figure shown below is not the final value for the campaign. Wow.)



Over the period 2007-2016, Mundito has provided almost \$516k to our nonprofit partners. See Table 1 for details.

### **Expenses:**

All agency donations (i.e. donations from everyone but the Founding Directors) flow directly to our nonprofit partners. Half of the target grants and all administrative and fundraising expenses are covered by the Founding Directors. Expenses for Mundito Foundation continue to be very low. Over the past several years, our administrative and fundraising expenses have remained relatively constant, while our grants have been increasing. Here is a breakdown of our cash expenses for 2016:

- 94% Program expenses (grants to partner nonprofits from agency donations and Mundito general fund)
- 5% Administrative expenses (primarily audited financial statement and tax filing)
- 1% Fundraising (refreshments for Meet Mundito parties, stamps, office supplies)

Mundito has no salary expenses, makes no payments to board members, and makes no payments for the use of office space and equipment. Total cash administrative and fundraising expenses for 2015 were \$5,350, entirely covered by the Founding Directors.

## Notes for Table 1:

- (1) Checking account was high on 12/31/14 pending payment of \$19k to complete the target grant to Ashoka. Checking account was high on 12/31/15 pending payment of a supplementary grant of \$6k to Plan International and to prepare for the launch of the spring 2016 campaign.
- (2) The brokerage account primarily contains donations by Mundito's Founding Directors for long-term stability of the organization. The brokerage account can also be used for in-kind donations of appreciated securities. Please contact us for details.
