Additionally, the meeting will be available on Zoom simultaneously and participants should sign on between 6:45 and 6:55 so that we may start on time. Our guest speaker, Kayleen Reusser, author-historian will be joining our program via Zoom from Ft. Wayne.

The Northside Events has established protocols for people attending. We must abide by their rules! The dining room is limited to **50** people maximum. Therefore, if you wish to attend, you MUST RSVP no later than **Sunday**, **9/27**—and you will receive a confirmation if there is space available.
