He is also a scholar of famed music institution - ITC SRA, Kolkata. Pt. Ghosh has performed at various venues within India and abroad. In the United States, he has performed at Music Circle, Pasadena; Norton Simon Museum, Pasadena; California State University, Los Angeles, Chandayan, New York; and LearnQuest Academy of Music Waltham, MA, to name a few. Apart from performing at various musical concerts within India and abroad, Pt. Ghosh also conducts music workshops. He is also a visiting lecturer and examiner at University of Rabindra Bharati, Kolkata and an acclaimed artist at All India Radio. Pt.
