

# Funeral Services For Warren Henne Held Sunday

Funeral services for Warren Henne, who died in Harper Hospital, Detroit, May 21, after an illness of only three weeks with a brain tumor, were held in the Bay Port Methodist church Sunday afternoon. Rev. Henry Kuhlman, pastor of the church officiated. Interment in the New Bay Port cemetery.

Warren Henne, son of Mr. and Mrs. Herman Henne, was born September 24, 1905 in Bay Port. With the exception of two years while he was a student at Albion College, his whole life was in Bay Port. He attended the Bay Port school and was a graduate of the class of 1923. He then attended Albion college. In the fall of 1925 he entered the employ of the Wallace & Morley Co. as an assistant to his father, Herman Henne, manager of the chain of grain elevators owned by that company. He continued in that capacity until his last illness.

Mr. Henne, when first taken ill entered the Scheurer Hospital, where he remained for ten days and after a few days at home went to Harper Hospital on May 15th. He was a member of the Methodist church.

He leaves to mourn his loss, a wife, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Herman Henne of Bay Port, two brothers, James of Cadillac and Ralph of Bay Port; seven sisters, Mrs. Stanley Treat of Huntington Woods, Mrs. Harry Sullivan and Mrs. Samuel Anker of Bay Port, Mrs. Edward Jeroue of Berkley, Mrs. Bob Wooley of Lansing, Mrs. Roland Kuhl of Berkley and Kathleen Henne of East Lansing.
