

Turners Rod & Reel Club Freshwater Tournament Rules (revised 4/1/2023)

- Tournament is for Club members only. None of your fish caught before your club dues are paid are eligible.
- You may begin to fish as soon as the lake opens.
- You may weigh 5 fish of any major game species in the lake. Total weight of five fish will determine your entry weight.
- Lake size and possession limit must be observed for all fish. All fish must be legally caught per the California Department of Fish and Wildlife Regulations.
- Time and place to turn in your slips will be announced in the newsletter by the Freshwater Chair. If he is unable to stay the entire time, an alternate will be indicated in the newsletter.
- Changes to each event, if any, will be announced at the meeting just prior to event by email to all members, on the Facebook page and by group text. In case of last minute weather changes, you can call the Freshwater Chair to inquire.
- All weights will be recorded and points applied towards the "Freshwater Angler of the Year Award." Freshwater Angler of the Year Award is a separate award from the Angler of the Year Award. If you wish to submit your Freshwater fish for the Whopper Board you can do so with a separate entry/photo per the Whopper Board rules.
- A Club hat will be awarded at the next Club meeting to the winner of each event.

Participation Rule Change: Freshwater Angler of the Year must attend at least 1 Club Freshwater event.

Point system is as follows:

Show up to fish10 points This will be eliminated starting the 2023 fishing year.

1st place20 points

2nd place15 points

3rd place.....10 points

If you attend Freshwater events you need to report to the Freshwater Chair what you caught by the designated time that day. (You can text results to event leader by the designated deadline.)
