HIGH SIERRA TEAM PLAY BLAWS

ARTICLE I PURPOSE

The purpose of this club is to promote Women's golf through team tournaments.

ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP

Membership in this club shall consist of the existing member clubs. Any additional clubs must be approved by a majority vote of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE III GOVERNING BODY

Each member club shall appoint a Team Captain and Co-Captain. They shall be the governing body of the club. Each Team Captain or their representative shall have one vote.

ARTICLE IV EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee shall consist of a President, Secretary and Treasurer.

In each even numbered year the HSTP Chair shall appoint a Nominating Committee Chair. The Nominating Committee Chair, along with her committee, shall develop a slate of nominees for each Executive Board position at least 30 days prior to Fall HSTP meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor.

They shall be elected on even years at the Fall Meeting by a majority vote of the Team Captains. Nominations may be made from the floor. They will serve a two year term.

SECTION I

President

Shall preside over the annual meetings.
Shall inform the delegates of all issues concerning the Member Clubs.

Secretary

Shall compile and keep a roster of the clubs, their Team Captains and Co-Captains.
Shall record the minutes of the meetings.
Shall distribute correspondence as necessary.

Treasurer

Shall collect, deposit and disperse all funds.
Shall present reports at the meetings.

ARTICLE V MEETINGS

There will be two meetings per year. The HSTP meetings will be held to coincide with the NNWGA delegate meetings in the Spring and Fall. A majority of the Team Captains present shall be a quorum.

ARTICLE VI DUES

Each club shall pay an annual membership fee. The fee will be set at the Fall meeting of the Team Captains and will be due by March 1st of each year.

ARTICLE VII AMENDMENTS

These bylaws may be amended at the annual meeting by a majority vote of the Team Captains, provided that written or electronic notice has been given thirty days prior to the meeting.

ARTICLE VII PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in the most current edition of "Robert's Rules of Order-Newly Revised" shall govern the Club in all cases in which it is not inconsistent with the Bylaws and any special rules of order the Club may adopt.
