ARTIST & CRAFTER INFORMATION

- **Reserve your space:** with the enclosed application or online at www.vancouverwinejazz.com.
- **Artist Sales:** 100% of your sales go to you! We do not take a percentage of sales. Booth Fees help pay for Festival advertising, marketing and promotion—which brings more qualified buyers to YOU.
- **Location, Artist Space & Electricity:** Esther Short Park, in Vancouver, WA. A Single Space is 10 X 10 feet and a Double Space is 10 X 20 feet. Electricity and Exhibitor Passes are included.
- **Jurying of Art:** If you are a FIRST-TIME participant, you are required to submit samples to our Jury. The Festival does not accept imports, co-ops or 3rd party galleries. Returning artists receive priority before we open the Festival up to new artists. Returning artists are exempt from jury. (See application for all details)
- **Booth Fee:** Booth Fee is \$300 for a Single Booth. Submit your Agreement & Booth Fee by April 10th to get this discount price. Price increases to \$450 after deadlines!

BOOTH FEE DISCOUNT

Return your application by April 10th and save \$150 on your booth fee. The price is \$300 for a single booth and \$600 for a double booth. Your booth fee includes:

- 3-Day Artist Space and 2 Exhibitor Passes per day
- Electrical Power (5-amp 600-watt/120-volt electrical outlet, \$100 value)
