Additional trips are being planned and information will be shared next month.


The MidOhio produce truck will be in on Thursdays, June 13 and 27, and the commodities boxes will arrive on Tuesday, June 18.

This is a common phrase we hear from our clients in the Adult Daycare Services program, so we have fun engaging all parts of their bodies and minds. We serve 8 individuals who have dementia or Alzheimer's. For 4 hours every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday,

we use conversation, chair exercise, music, art and games to enhance their quality of life and give their caregivers a much-needed break. We want to add some new dementia-oriented activities and resources to our collection and want to raise about \$500 to purchase them. Reusable water painting palettes are one example of a tool we can use repeatedly to provide a clean, safe and creative outlet for our clients. Updating our music cd collection and purchasing special finger fidget items are also on our list.




