DESCRIPTION: Benge and Zebrawood riser. Comfortable grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; 2 filled sight screw holes on the back of the sight window glass (see last pic). A few faint superficial stress lines. No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing. Some minor discoloration of the green limb fiberglass. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are visible but very faded. Overall, this is a really nice bow in very good condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held under pressure. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
