Walking in Christ: part 3

2 Corinthians 5:16-17 Therefore from now on we recognize no one according to the flesh; even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him in this way no longer. Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

When we enter into a relationship with Christ we are fundamentally transformed. Our transformation is visible, tangible. People who have experienced the power of God in their life are noticeably different. They create a stir, and cause those who know them to question what has gotten into them. Think of Ebenezer Scrooge at the end of Charles Dickens' *A Christmas Carol*. Scrooge is an entirely different person after his conversion experience that night. 

Trustees' Report

The Trustees would like to thank the congregation for their patience through this lengthy renovation process. We're heading down the home stretch.

As I write this, the new handicapped accessible restroom in the Elm Street Lounge/Chapel is usable and only needs a few finishing touches before it's complete. The rest of the Elm Street Lounge/Chapel is currently receiving a fresh coat of paint. During our last meeting, we approved a plan from Atlantic Equipment Specialists to equip the new kitchen. The furnishings and equipment includes a microwave oven, countertop convection oven, a two door commercial refrigerator, a single door commercial freezer, a prep counter and island, a three bowl sink and wire storage racks. Because everything needed to be ordered, we anticipate it will be six to eight weeks until completion. The remaining projects in the church are the replacement of an electrical panel that is outdated and potentially unsafe and new stair treads and flooring inside the Center Street entrance.

The refurbishing of the first floor of the Parish House is coming along nicely. The walls have new wallboard over the old plaster and a fresh coat of paint. New ceiling and lighting has been installed. After many years of having to go to the church to use the restroom facilities, there will be a working restroom again. When the rooms to the left of the entrance are completed the current office will be moved into another room to allow the current office to be refurbished.

Lay Leader's Report

Crossroads of Life, the UMC-sponsored central Illinois Prison Faith Community with which I've recently become involved, recently invited me to join their board, and I accepted. The board makes decisions about the directions, projects and funding guidelines by which the ministry functions to bring faith-based care and support to men and women behind bars in the area's state correctional facilities. The board meets almost entirely by e-mail on an ad hoc basis, depending on issues at hand. I have already voted twice for them, both times on questions of Crossroads' internal financial arrangements. I'll continue to support this ministry, both financially and from an advisory standpoint, as it has gotten off the ground and is beginning to fly according to the fondest hopes of its visionary leaders. It's another great success story, brought to us by God, who makes all things possible and writes the book on things like this.

Plans were finalized that I conduct the full Traditional Sunday morning worship services on April 23 and June 25, in the first instance to substitute for the Pastor during his vacation and in the second to be intertransitional pulpit supply while he departs for his new appointment in Towanda.

Soup and The Word 2017 ended beautifully on April 12 with a fine homily by Cynthia Dallas-Kirk of St. Paul's AME Church. Pastor Damien and I also attended the event on March 26, when Kingdom Kidz performed. During the Kidz' show, one of the puppets broke out with the Aaronic Benediction from the Book of Numbers – in the original Hebrew. Now that was a surprise that put me back in my chair about seven inches, because I've only ever heard it live in that language once before, during a 2014 college lecture by a Hungarian Jewish archaeologist. Never from a puppet at a local ecumenical noon-hour service.

Ad Board

As mentioned above, Bethany will host a hot dog giveaway to take place in front of the church during the June 17 Milton Bicentennial Parade. The Board has approved this approach to serving the community in lieu of having a joint church Community Picnic Lunch and Worship Service at Brown Avenue Park on June 11 (the cancellation of which was forced by the unavailability of a park pavilion). The parade-time giveaway, however, will still be conducted by a team of folks from the various churches that normally partner with us as Community Dinner sponsors, and all of our "coalition" churches will chip in to supply physical assistance and support the food. We had considered giving away French fries, also, but the Board declined to accept that idea because of the envisioned labor intensity and the logistics of it.

The Board approved a two-week solicitation of non-perishable foods to be brought in to Bethany in the first two weeks of May in connection with the Milton Bicentennial food drive. That's tantamount to extending our routinely-scheduled May 7 "Share the Table" Sunday to include May 14, such that the combined collection can be taken to the food bank all at once. This one-time "doubling of the effort" will be announced orally during the April 23 and April 30 Traditional services, and it will appear in our service bulletins as appropriate.

PSPRC has many things on its plate with regard to its purview of Bethany's human resources. Two of our paid Contemporary service employees will soon be leaving us to take on new ventures, and there are many facets of the impending transition from Pastor Brooks to Pastor McNeal that affect church plans and late June / early July timing. Plans are being consummated to fill the paid positions and to ensure a seamless pastoral changeover.
