From the very beginning God reveals Himself in the Bible as Father, Creator of the universe and all Powerful, all Knowing and ever Present.

Present with Him in Heaven is Jesus, who was also there from the beginning; the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. Colossians 1:15

Hovering over the created universe even before the beginning was the Holy Spirit... the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. Genesis 1:2

The Holy Spirit is sometimes portrayed as a dove.

For example when Jesus was baptised, a dove was seen to come down onto Him. As He was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended on Him in bodily form like a dove. Luke 3:21

So the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of God. When we open our hearts and our minds to what Jesus has done for us when He died on the Cross, and permit Him to be Lord over our lives, God gives us His Spirit as a seal. Having believed, you

were marked in Him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit. Ephesians 1:13

He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. Philippians 1:6.


This is the day when Jesus actually returns to take us to be with Him forever. Some may go to be with Him before this day, if we have finished our life here on the earth.

That seal on our hearts speaks to our spirit – our inner self – that we are precious children of our heavenly Father. He disciplines those He loves just like any good father so


