Local Law Numbered 1 of the year 2002

A Local Law amending Local Law Number 2 of the year 1977 entitled "controlling traffic within the Village of Cohocton, New York".

Be It enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cohocton as follows:

- 1) Article VI, Section 81 of Local Law Number 2 of the Year 1977 is amended to include the following as a stop intersection:

	<u>Intersection of:</u>	<u>With:</u>	<u>Stop Sign On:</u>	<u>Entrance From:</u>
11.	Marks Road	Loon Lake Road (County Road 121) (SR962D)	Marks Road	South

- 2) Article VI, Section 83 is amended to remove the following designated yield intersection:

	<u>Intersection of:</u>	<u>With/And Yield Sign On:</u>	<u>Entrance From:</u>
	Marks Road	Loon Lake Road (Route 121)	South

- 3) Any parts or part of this local law which are subject to the approval from the New York State Department of Transportation pursuant to Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 1684 shall take effect from and after the day on which such approval in writing is received.
- 4) This local law shall take effect upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State except those parts, if any, which are subject to approval under Section 1684 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.


