The early 1970's Thunderbolt featured a phenolic and Bubinga (or other select hardwoods) riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. A couple of minor "runs" in the varnish. Decals are a bit faded but legible. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age

# Thunderbolt



This is the short hunter that has shown the way. York introduced the Thunderbolt in 1959 and it has since become the standard of the industry. Although others have followed you'll not find another short hunting bow that performs like the Thunderbolt. This one draws smoothly without "stack" and shoots with real authority. It has become a favorite weapon among bowhunters.

And now for 1971 the Thunderbolt is better than ever. Look at the rare beauty in the handle section. Placed where it adds strength as well as eye appeal, the high compression phenolic is combined with exotic imported hardwoods. It is carefully contoured for a natural, comfortable feel. This is a high performance bow. Try it. Available for both right and left handed archers.
