1912-1992

Charles F. Taschner, 80 of Gagetown, passed away Friday, July 17, in Hills and Dales Hospital, Cass City, following a long illness.

Mr. Taschner was born in Sebewaing on March 10, 1912. He graduated from Sebewaing High School in the Class of 1930. On Feb. 4, 1939, he was united in marriage with Ellen Anderson, and she preceded him in death on Jan. 6, 1971.

On Feb. 23, 1974, he was married to Eva Mein-inger in St. Agatha Church, Gagetown, and she survives him.

Mr. Taschner was a member of St. Agatha Church and of Knights of Columbus. He farmed in the Owendale and Elkton area for many years and served as postmaster at Owendale. Prior to his retirement he worked in maintenance of grain storage bins in this area.

Surviving Mr. Taschner, in addition to his wife, Eva of Gagetown, are two daughters, Lucille (Orvel) Roggenbuck of Snover and Beverly (Burce) Mellendorf of Fairgrove, 12 grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, three stepchildren, John (Agnes) Meininger of Gagetown, Marion Weltin of Cass City and Ann (Ed) Bumhoffer of Elkton, 15 step-grandchildren, 13 step-great-grandchildren, and three sisters, Irene Lorenz of Tawas, Edna (John) Knott of Zephyrhills, FL, and Lorene (Carl) Engelhardt of Sebewaing.

He was preceded in death by three brothers, Daniel Taschner, Frank Taschner and Roland Hafner, and one sister, Dorothy Buschbacher.
