The arrow pictured here is the custom tournament field arrow. Tapered cedar, 10 gr. matching, 5" feather, in white or dyed white fletching (red, yellow, orange or any combo), choice of any field point. Black diamond 130-150 gr. Ace 160 gr. Hills 125 gr. Warrior 125 gr. ( $\frac{1}{10}$  size takes 100 gr. and 70 gr. field point). This arrow can be supplied in  $\frac{1}{32}$ ,  $\frac{5}{16}$ , or  $\frac{9}{32}$  shafts for bows from 30 to 70 lbs. Tournament field, \$11.50 dozen; with barred feathers, \$10.50 dozen.

We cannot recommend too highly the Ace and Black Diamond field points. Ace is 160 gr. and Black Diamond 150 and 130 gr. These taper bore points take up more shock and reduce arrow breakage better than any point we have tried. Ace is probably best small game point because of square faced style; Black Diamond is probably best all purpose. Both are very good.



The arrow illustrated is the tournament target arrow. Same general specifications as tournament field except target point. Generally a smaller feather is used on target arrows because of the longer ranges. (York Round 100 yds.) We recommend 3" feathers on 50 shafts, 4" feathers on 11 shafts. However, this is a custom arrow and we make to order 3, 4 and 5" feathers. With whites and dyed whites, \$10.50 dozen. With grey and dyed grey, \$9.50 dozen.



These are strictly custom grade. Closely matched in spine and 10 gr. weight. Fletched with Rhode Spiro clamps. Unless otherwise ordered 5" feathers on \$\frac{1}{2}\$ shafts, 4" on \$\frac{1}{2}\$s shafts. Note: Hill's Hornet, Panther 2, Panther 4, MA3, Hi-Precision, Ace Hi-Speed, Ace Jet, Black Diamond are heads available with \$\frac{5}{16}\$ ferrules. Above prices are gray bar feathers or dyed red, yellow, blue, orange, green, or any combination. # **EASTON ALUMINUM ARROWS**

The plus ultra in arrows. This arrow is so good that it would be difficult to find a champion who doesn't use them. Since James Easton perfected his system of controlled wall thickness for spine matching, many competitive archery round records have been broken—and by a considerable margin. Perhaps it would be safe to say all records have been broken. Because of the cost we do not recommend Eastons for everyone. But we certainly do recommend them to the serious archer who is shooting a reasonably good score and who wants to improve that score. If the price seems high it must be remembered that a set of aluminiums will out-wear three sets of woods. Fletched in any combination or choice of feathers. Specify bow weights, arrow lengths.
