

From Table to Table, a Devotional for the week of March 23, 2020

The passage for Sunday, March 29, is Mark 2.13-22.

Message title: To Eat or Not to Eat

Today read verses 13-14:

13Once again Jesus went out beside the lake. A large crowd came to him, and he began to teach them.

14As he walked along, he saw Levi son of Alphaeus sitting at the tax collector's booth. "Follow me," Jesus told him, and Levi got up and followed him.

- Where does Jesus find you this morning? Are you "coming to him", "at your work", "about your business"? Are you in hiding? Being told we need to stay home is not the same thing as withdrawing, hiding, cutting off.
- When Jesus says, "Follow me", what does that mean to you today? It likely looks much different than it did even 2 weeks ago. Pay attention to what you see and hear. Listen and respond. His will be the Voice that brings calm and not fear, the Voice that encourages and carries hope.
