Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walkthrough is restricted to handlers entered in that class. Walkthroughs will be held prior to each class.

Entry Fees

each includes an AKC recording fee \$20-each run, each dog, each day (\$3.50 AKC RF) **Jr Handler entry fees are reduced by \$10/day** All entered dogs will receive 1 toy/dog for the weekend. Titling Classes: A green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to avalifying doas placing 1st - 4th and to those completing titles. A large rosette and MACH bar will be awarded to teams completing a MACH title. A large rosette & PACH bar will be awarded to teams completing a PACH title. All awards must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed.

Exhibitor Information

Club or AKC event clothing may be worn by anyone. Clothing may display the person's name, dog's call name &/or the dog's picture, but no titles. Writing or graphics must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. Clothing must not display any info that would be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial.

Junior Handlers

PLEASE indicate on the entry form whether a Junior handler will be running the dog, and also include their JH number and date of birth. It is now required for the AKC catalogs, and addition after scoring of a trial has begun is difficult!

Hotel Information



Directions to the Trial and Show Site Information

Crating space: Crating is in a separate building! *(see p3 for more crating info)* All crates and xpens MUST have plastic or a tarp underneath them (please bring your own waterproof material!). Crates may be left overnight; however, CATC will not be responsible for lost/damaged items left at the site. No setup until Friday!

No overnight parking or RVs will be allowed at the trial site.

Concessions: There are variety of fast food and casual restaurants within a short driving distance. Directions: From all directions, take I-270 to Exit 49 (Alum Creek Dr) on the South side of Columbus; turn North onto Alum Creek Dr to Williams Road (1.0mi); then turn left (West) onto Williams. Travel West for 0.2mi, and the CATC facility will be on your right (North).



Notice to Exhibitors

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **Puppies** under 4 months of age are prohibited from the show grounds.

All dogs must be on leash or confined except when being judged or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Express delivery entries must include a signature permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address without the recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign for receipt, entries may be returned to sender. ***Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on an official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with <u>signed Agreement</u> and Instructions attached cannot be accepted.***

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. Confirmation of acceptance will be made if either an email address or a self-addressed, stamped postcard with checkboxes for each class entered is included with the entry.

Owners are responsible for **errors made while filling out entry forms**, whoever makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully to minimize errors! Every effort will be made to find all **duplicate entries**; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Make all checks and money orders **payable to CATC** in US funds only. Please mail fees with entries. The Trial Secretary and CATC assume no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Postdated or returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20 service charge for returned checks.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the event committee. No fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed in the event of riots, civil disturbances, fire, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the trial committee. Entry fees less \$5 per run will be refunded for injured or contagious dogs or bitches in season on the day of the trial if veterinary certification is submitted promptly. 50% of entry fees will be refunded for dogs whose handler cannot compete due to injury if medical documentation is submitted. Overpayment of less than \$10 per dog per day will not be refunded except at the exhibitor's request.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. Handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when it is their turn to run. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Columbus All-breed Training Club and its agents assume **no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury** sustained by exhibitors, handlers, their dogs or property, or their children.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive or blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Crating & Setup Info - CATC Building

Crating for this trial will be in a separate building ("Building A") from the one housing the agility ring. It is a very short walk from one building to the other. Both of these buildings are heated and airconditioned. The building will open for crating setup no later than <u>one hour prior to start of judging</u> each day. There will <u>NOT be setup Thursday</u> evening! *All crates must be placed on a waterproof (impermeable) mat or plastic to be supplied by the exhibitor.*

Ubstacles

All obstacles will conform to requirements as specified in the current revision of the "Regulations for Agility Trials" from the American Kennel Club (available at www.akc.org).

For Exhibition Only (FEO) & Fix and GoOn (FnG)

- For Exhibition Only (FEO) will allow exhibitors to work with dogs in a trial environment, in the T2B & FAST classes only. FEO runs are trial entries - must enter in advance in the desired jump height
- Fix and GoOn—allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation.

Height Divisions & Mixed Height/Mixed Class Entries

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All heights are as measured at the withers. Dogs measuring into the 8 thru 20" Regular divisions may optionally enter the 24C division .

Regular Class (Preferred Class) jump height divisions:

8/4/inchesfor dogs	11 inches and under
12/8/inchesfor dogs	14 inches and under
16/12/inchesfor dogs	18 inches and under

- 20/16/inches.. for dogs 22 inches and under
- 24/20/inches.. for dogs over 22 inches
- 24C division .. for dogs 22" and under at owner's discretion *(n/a Preferred)*

Dogs entered in **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in Regular classes as listed above.

- Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/ or during a trial weekend
- Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day
 - \Rightarrow Separate entry forms must be submitted for each jump height &/or division (Reg/Pref) entered

Random Draw Entry Method

Entries accepted no sooner than Tuesday, May 27th at 8am;

Finish date for entry into the random draw is Wednesday, June 11th at 4pm. Random draw will be held on Weds, June 11th at 6pm, at the Trial Secretary's home (see pg2). Entries close 4pm Wednesday, July 2nd. If entry limits are not reached during the opening period, they will be filled on a "first received" basis until the closing date.

Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary for the random draw. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be treated as an invalid entry and will be returned.

In the event an envelope is drawn that contains entries that would exceed the entry limit, there will be a random draw of the individual entries contained therein to fill the specified entry limit. If the entry limit is reached during the draw, all remaining entries shall be drawn for a position on the waitlist. All Random Draw rules and regs as they appear in Ch1, Sec16 of the Regs for Agility Trials shall apply.

Pre-trial Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner. This request must be made to the Trial Secretary by 6pm on Monday, July 14th, by mail or e-mail (see form on p.9). Day-to-day move-ups must be requested in writing at the trial site before the close of trial on the preceding day.

Confirmations, Corrections, Entry Changes, and E-mail

Per AKC regulations, changes to entries may be made until the closing date. After that time, only moveups are permitted until the moveup deadline. Corrections to entries due to Secretarial error may be requested at any time; however, any day of show corrections cannot be guaranteed to be reported to AKC correctly!!. Preliminary confirmations will be emailed within 7 days of receipt of your entry if a valid email address is provided; PLEASE be sure to add **TrialSec@furrydogs.com** to your address book/whitelist to ensure the email reaches you, so you can check your information promptly!

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

There is a section on the entry form to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card. Please check the appropriate box so the Trial Sec knows whether to include your dog on the To Be Measured List. It is not required to submit copies of jump height cards with entries or during check-in. It is solely the exhibitor's responsibility to check the correct box, enter the correct height, have dogs measured before running if necessary, and have height card(s) available to present, if requested.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered at the event indicated above and only if approved by the Trial Secretary.

Waitlist for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time

CATC is offering a Waitlist to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/ time. A maximum of 30 runs per trial day will be placed on the club's waitlist. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the normal closing date.

Any withdrawals that are received by 6pm **Thursday, July 10th** will be replaced by a waitlisted entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Withdrawals (except BIS or njury withdrawals) will not receive a refund if there are no waitlisted entries to backfill the withdrawn runs.

Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the above final withdrawal deadline will receive a full refund of waitlisted runs.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
