## Town of Stratton Selectmen's Meeting

August 24, 2020

**Present:** Selectmen: Al Dupell – Chair, Chris Liller, and Greg Marcucci and Clerk – Kent Young.

Al Dupell called the meeting to order at 7:30pm at the Stratton Town Office. Orders were reviewed and signed. No modifications to the Agenda were made.

**Road Crew Issues**: Chris Liller summarized ongoing projects underway. **Bear Creek Rd. / Mountain Rd. Culvert:** The Selectmen asked the Foreman to proceed working with Engineer, Ron Bell, regarding the replacement of the Bear Creek Rd. / Mountain Rd. culvert, which involves an easement needed from Meadowsend Timberland LTD in order to straighten a portion of Mountain Rd. at this site. The Foreman agreed to do so. Access Permit: The Selectmen reviewed a request for an access permit on W. Jamaica Rd. for a new owner of an undeveloped lot — Michael Call — located about 1500 ft. southwest of Shepardson Rd., on the east side. The Road Foreman had reviewed the site and agreed with its proposed location and that no culvert is needed. The Selectmen concurred and all members present signed to approve the application.

**Fire Alarm fees**: The Clerk stated that he had discussed the issue with the Fire Chief, who had contacted the property owner who has refused and continues to refuse to pay fees for false alarms assessed on them earlier in the year. The Selectmen agreed to have the Town Attorney review the town's recourse and proceed with his recommendation.

**Minutes:** Chris Liller moved to approve the Selectmen's Minutes of August 10, 2020. Greg Marcucci seconded. The minutes were approved.

**Adjourn**: Chris Liller motioned to adjourn at 7:40p.m.. Greg Marcucci seconded. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned.
