2. Progress since last meeting

- <u>Pilotage Best Practices Study</u> (Mark Gleason)
 - Study in progress, wrapping up white paper and looking at overall governance structure.
 - Looking over the last round of comments from the initial draft
 - Diving more into best practices. Will be spending a lot of time looking at Baltimore, Maryland including what the school district and the port of Baltimore has done.
 - BPC provided feedback, the pilots, PMSA, legislature, NWSA, Paul Kirchner/APA and working with that.
- <u>Status of 8/8 Meeting Action Items</u> (Sheri, Linda, Jaimie)
 - Sara Thompson ID'd goals and assigned names to tasks. Really nice to have it so well organized and spelled out.

 There is also a lot of activities to do. We do know if we reduce the number of pilots, and even if we don't, we believe we will need to offer a test sometime in 2019. SFBP is tracking to have the tests at the same time.

4. Recruitment Plan for 2018/2019 WA Marine Pilot Exam

- <u>Recruitment</u>
 - BPC charges 5K, SFBP charges 2K. 150 questions developed by pilots, with cut scores. Diff between WA & SFO is that they rated the candidates based on their application (skills & experience) in addition to the test.
 - Need to figure out how to expand the pool.
 - There is potential of losing 2 of our candidates to SFO. 1 already left for SFO.
 - SFO has18 charts, versus our 24. They don't have as many places to go. Their training program (more based on performance) is one year verses 18-24 months here with a very (the most) prescriptive program in the country. So a pilot has to go on stipend, which is typically less than what they're making as a captain. On the chance that they will get licensed, about 10% don't make it.
 - SFO sent Sheri their exam validation report (State HR Administers Exam).
 - The higher cost of taking test here may be a barrier to diversity.
 - Application Fee \$400 comes straight to the Board; goes to exam committee for determination of qualifications. If they don't qualify, you get your exam fee back.
 - o Exam Fee is \$2k.
 - Simulator Fee \$2,600 goes straight to Progeny.
 - Master will be leaving a 100K+ job and need a 4-5 month block of time to study (without a pay check) to pass. Many end up using

their retirement money or refinance house to cover income loss while studying to take the exam.

 - WSF participated in a JBLM Transition Summit, Sept 2017, it was a big event in which they had a booth.
 - The Navy (Orion) also has summit to help people find civilian jobs after they get out of the Navy.
 - o WISTA & Maritime Safety Committee email distribution list
 - Only 4 major publishing firms (i.e. Philips Publishing, gCaptain)
 - o Military group (USCG Foundation, Marine Exchange)
 - Women in the offshore; SeaSisters.org (watch out for clicking on blog comment links.)
- Exam Requirements/Candidate Pool
 - o The Navy (Orion) also has summit to help people find civilian jobs
 - Reinstate the exam committee to make recommendations, then
 BPC would have to approve any requirement changes
 - Would need to have the data that supports this change
 - USCG licensing requirements, are they a source of understanding who our universe is?
 - Pingle is a platform for connecting mariners with training programs and potentially a source for credible candidates
 - Perhaps FOIA list of people who meet certain requirements but first reach out to Senator Cantwell's office.
 - Question: how do we know where our biggest untapped pool is?
 Where are they working?

- Like a Navy Seal, we need a very targeted recruitment: huge barrier to entry and financial and personal sacrifices, but then you become a member of this elite group.
- BPC to consider additional simulation time to address testing for situational awareness and time on task – stay sharp & focuses with numerous balls in the air.
