

# LAWRENCE H. (BUD) PARSELL

## 1923 - 1996

Lawrence H. (Bud) Parsell, 72 of Akron, passed away late Saturday evening, Feb. 3, at the Tendercare Nursing Home in Cass City.

Bud, as he was known by family and friends, was born March 17, 1923 in Unionville to the late Jesse B. Parsell and Edna K. (Wing) Parsell. He attended the Unionville school.
