June 12, 2014 - Our speaker was Ms. Tammy Bresnahan, Associate State Director of Advocacy, MD AARP. She discussed some of the various activities of the MD AARP: how to work with aging populations, working with Annapolis legislators to ensure state employee retirement benefits, working to repeal part of law which said those over age 62 can get paid less than minimum wage, lobbying against aging pay prohibitions, efforts to repeal part of law prohibiting Medicare from negotiating with drug companies, and working with family caregivers. Ms. Bresnahan noted that each county has grants to support family caregivers and that information is available from the Worcester County Office on Aging.

RECORDING SECRETARY:

- Records the discussions at the board meetings and general meetings, noting all motions made and results. Keeps attendance of board members at board meetings.
- Prepares and distributes minutes to board members. Makes corrections as necessary.
 Maintains a file copy of each in Secretary's book.
- Sends notice to local papers regarding upcoming monthly meetings (3-4 weeks in advance).
- Prepares a roster of current board members for distribution to all board members.

BOARD MEMBER:

- Participates in monthly board meetings and membership meetings.
- o Provides input regarding chapter events (i.e. Health Fair, Special Events, Fund Raising Efforts, etc.)
- Votes on motions proposed by board members (i.e. Acceptance of Treasurer Report, Minutes, Special expense requests, etc.)

MEMBERSHIP CHAIRPERSON:

- Process new membership requests.
- Maintain database of active and recently active members. Telephone/e-mail recently active members who have not renewed (March).
- Provide e-mail addresses/changes to board members, travel committee members and person handling member e-mail communications.
- Prepare snail-mail addresses for annual postcard communication to membership
- Staff membership table at meeting.
- Maintain AARP table at Annual Health Fair
- WEBSITE MAINTENANCE: Maintain current website using inputs from Travel, Membership and other committees/board members.
- NEWSLETTER EDITOR: Write and print copies for distribution to members without e-mail addresses
 and to the president. Provide electronic copy to Webmaster. Newsletters are written/distributed every
 other month during our "active" season (January-March-May-September-November).
- CHAPTER HISTORIAN: Accumulate historical documents (newsletters, newspaper articles, etc.), photograph important events, do research, provide information to webmaster and create digital record and archives.
- E-MAIL COMMUNICATIONS: Write and distribute e-mail meeting reminders and other e-mails, as needed to membership. Maintain Membership e-mail addresses on the e-mail service.
