Curbside Garbage Service

- Pickup once per week in provided 96-gallon wheeled cart.
- Garbage must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include: hazardous waste, liquid waste, tires, animal carcasses, yard waste.
- All items must be placed in the cart in order for it to be collected.

Curbside Recycling Service

- Available for customers participating in the recycling program. If you would like to sign up for recycling services at no additional cost, please contact us at (888) 443-1717.
- Pickup **EVERY OTHER WEEK** in provided 64-gallon cart.
- Moving forward, recyclables in 18-gallon bins will no longer be collected. Residents are welcomed to keep the existing bins free of charge, or return bins to the Howell DPW at 150 Marion Street.
- Recyclables must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items accepted for pickup include: bi-metal and aluminum cans, plastics #1, #2, #4, #5, #6 and #7, corrugated cardboard, newsprint and magazines, clear, green and brown container glass.
- All items must be placed in the cart in order for it to be collected.

Yard Waste Service

- Pickup once per week on the same day as garbage from April thru November.
- Yard waste must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Branches must be bundled and not to exceed 36

inches in length.

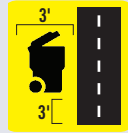
- Yard waste should **ONLY** be placed in paper bags or in a resident-owned 32-gallon container.
- Yard waste is **NOT** accepted in plastic bags, 18-gallon recycling bins or resident-owned recycling containers.
- **Containers should not exceed 32 gallons.**

Bulk Waste Service

- **Only 1 bulk item is permitted per week.**
- Bulk waste must be placed curbside the night before, or prior to 6 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include: construction and demolition debris, tires or anything that cannot be safely removed by a crew of two. Freon items will not be taken unless the refrigerant has been removed by a certified technician and properly stickered as such.

Cart Placement

- **Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from the curb.**
- **There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.**
- **Be sure to place garbage and recycling carts on opposite sides of the driveway.**
- **Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.**
