1918-1994

Raymond F. Krauss, 76, longtime Sebawang farmer, died Wednesday morning, Dec. 28, at Bay Medical Center, Bay City, following a brief illness.

He was born in Sebawang on March 11, 1918, the son of Otto and Martha (Winter) Krauss. He was married to Aldine "Toots" Rothhaus in 1949, and she preceded him in death in May, 1979. He married Helen Lentner Aug. 29, 1988, in Kilmarnock, and she survives him.

Mr. Krauss had labored in the Sebawang Area for many years and was employed at the Michigan Sugar Company and Vollmer Beverage Company before retiring 10 years ago.

He was a lifelong member of Immanuel Lutheran Church where he had been a trustee. He was an avid bowler.
