Quail Ridge Tennis & Swim Club Rules and Regulations

MEMBER:

Persons to whom a membership certificate has been issued. Offspring, adopted children, and children who members are the legal guardian of, while not considered guests, are not considered to be members and therefore have limitations associated with facility usage.

GUEST:

A person invited by a member to use the pool or tennis facilities. All members are entitled to invite guests with the following restrictions:

- 1. No resident of the Quail Ridge community may be a guest.
- 2. Members are limited to six guests at a time unless the event is a party previously authorized by the Board of Directors; more than six guests shall be considered a party. The inviting member must sign in for the guest, review the pool rules and regulations with the guest, and accompany the guest while the facilities are being used. Members are responsible for their guest's behavior.
- 3. No guest, other than an overnight housequest or a babysitter, may be a guest more than once a week.
- 4. Offspring of a member, adopted children of a member, and children who members are the legal guardians of, may invite only two guests per day.
- 5. Unaccompanied guests will be instructed to leave the pool by any member.

POOL PARTY: Members only, may rent the facilities for a party **Monday through Sunday** during normal pool hours for no fee, once per year. Rental is \$50 thereafter. The renting member must remain for the duration of the party and be responsible for the general cleanliness of the facility – all garbage must be bagged, closing the facility and turning off all lights and water. The renting member must post a sign designating the time and date at least one week prior to the party with the understanding that the Party will not exclude Members wanting to use the facilities during that time. The \$50 charge is a token amount to offset costs and inconvenience to other members when a party is held with a large group of non-members. We do rent the facilities to non-members with pre-approval from the Board of Directors.

CONDUCT:

A member, lifeguard or pool manager may, after warning, eject swimmers refusing to abide by the Pool Rules and Regulations. Flagrant violations are subject to action by the Board of Directors.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Pool and tennis court facilities are for the exclusive use of members and invited quests.
- 2. Members and guests must sign in.
- 3. Unless a lifeguard is on duty, **any children under 16** must be accompanied by a responsible adult (18 years old minimum).
- 4. Members and guests must shower before swimming.
- 5. Swimmers must be free of communicable diseases, skin, eye, ear or nasal infection.
- 6. Swimmers must wear swimsuits or proper swimming attire.
- 7. No diving into pool except from the diving board and/or the designated 8' area of the pool.
- 8. No rowdy behavior (such as popping of towels, roughness, running, spouting water, use of profanity).
- 9. Alcoholic beverages are permitted inside the fenced area. Preferably in a cup but cans can be used as long as the labels and logos are not visible to other members.
- 10. No bottles, glass or breakable containers.
- 11. No swimming or wading unaccompanied.
- 12. Defacing pool equipment (chairs/umbrellas in the pool, unhooking floatation ropes, etc.) is not permitted.
- 13. Pets are prohibited inside the fenced area.
- 14. Pool members are required to clean up after themselves and guests (removing trash, lowering umbrellas, turning off lights, straightening chairs).
- 15. Telephone usage should be limited to 2 minutes per call.
- **16.** All vehicles/golf carts should be parked in a designated parking space. **Golf carts will not be parked in the grass.**
- 17. Members found to have given out their gate badge to non-members or in violation of guest restriction policies, will be given a warning for their first offense and a loss of usage rights for 30 days for subsequent violations. The loss of usage rights will apply to all members and offspring in the household.

*Violations of any of the above rules will be cause for immediate dismissal/suspension of pool use until a meeting with the pool board members.

This is your pool; you are responsible to help maintain the cleanliness of the pool. If you find anything broken or needs attention, please feel free to contact any board member.
