## Patterson, Eileen R.

Eileen R. Patterson, 92, of Bad Axe, died Friday morning, February 25, 2005 at Courtney Manor in Bad Axe following a long illness. Mrs. Patterson was born January 3, 1913 in Liverpool, England.
