SPUMC operates a “Bags and Books” program on Monday mornings during the summer. Beginning June 16 we will give bags containing books, activity books, and other goodies to every child whose parent or guardian comes to our church’s food pantry.

I had the privilege of talking with the youth a few weeks ago and invited them to volunteer with Bags and Books. Each Monday from 9am until 12 noon we use 6-8 youth and adults to organize boxes of bags, help parents get the right bags, and keep track of supplies we use. With some age groups we help parents choose books. Parents get in line early for needed food from the pantry and have no idea kids will get their own bags, while some have come in the past summers and are glad to see us and again receive special gifts for their child.

It takes a lot of hours to prepare appropriate bags for age groups (babies through HS Seniors). As you plan your summer, we hope you will schedule a few Mondays to help with Bags and Books.
