In the past, I've even used the comment, "If I go in there the roof will surely cave in, or, lightening will strike us all" to keep me from going in. The truth of the matter is that Jesus wants us to come to Him in whatever state of mind or lifestyle we are in.

Being someone that loves to fish and buy t-shirts I bought a t-shirt that has a picture of a big fish on the front of it and the caption above the fish reads, "You catch'em and let God clean' em." To me this is saying our job is to share the Gospel, the Good News, love on people, get them to church and then God will use His Holy Spirit to get them cleaned up in a way that ONLY He can do. Jesus has an open door, come as you are policy but sadly enough it was the spirit of self-righteous-ness that shunned most of us away, NOT Jesus! Let me see if I can explain this through my own life as a young boy. Remember, these were the things going on in my life but I also believe there were two different perceptions involved, mine and theirs. The church that our family attended was one full of rules/laws that we had to do or could not do or else I believed I was going to go to HELL! They taught us from the same Word of God that I still read today, the Holy Bible. They did attempt to train us up in the way that we should go. (*Proverbs 22:6*) We were taught to memorize Bible verses, play well with others, be kind to each other and, "Don't you dare cut up in church or I'll jerk a knot in your butt!" It mostly seemed to me then, that there was a law or a rule regarding everything. We weren't allowed to go to the movies; women were not supposed to wear jewelry or use makeup. The clothing issues the church had never really affected us boys as much as they did the girls due to the fact that jeans and a t-shirt were fitting for us. We couldn't go to the beach for fear we would see girls half-dressed in bathing suits. That was referred to as "swimming in mixed company." Being boys we could slip off to what we referred to as "the freeway ponds" to swim and cut up. I guess the girls were stuck squirting each other

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with the water hose, I don't really know. Listening to Rock-n-Roll was "the devil's music" and heaven forbid we have a desire to attend the school dances. If you smoked cigarettes you couldn't be a member of the church and for sure you were going to Hell. If you had been married and then ended up divorced with your spouse still alive, you weren't suppose to marry again or the church looked down on you. And if I wasn't at the altar crying and belly aching once a week, begging for forgiveness, I thought I was going to Hell. It got to the point where I began to wonder what I had done so terrible from one week to the next that God would be so mad at me. Yes, you can probably look nearly every one of those "rules/laws" they gave us up in the **Book of Leviticus**.

I am by no means attempting to paint an ugly picture of the church setting I grew up in. In fact some of the church family and friends I had then are still in my life today, and even to this day when I visit that church family in Ohio my mind always reflects to some of my fondest memories ever. I will also say that those Holy Ghost filled, speaking in tongues services, where people stood up and boldly testified to the Glory of God in their lives, are the very foundation I believe in and stand on still today! What I'm leading to is this. All of those rules only seemed to make me more aware of sin due to the way I understood it all then. It seemed that I became more sin conscious than God conscious. I know today that they were only trying to teach me to say no to sin. I love to read the words of the Apostle Paul. His words help me see that he was not only like us but for our sake he was transparent and explained his/our sinful nature. See if you can relate to Paul's words here in Romans 7:15-16 (NLT), "I don't really understand myself, for I want to do what is right but I don't do it. But if I know that what I am doing is wrong, this shows that the law is good." In other words, it's like when we are driving down a road and see the speed limit sign posted just ahead of us. The sign helps us be aware whether or not we are breaking the law. The sign/law has served its purpose. Drop down a few more verses to Romans 7:18-19, "I want to do what is right, but I can't. I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway." Paul's words might sound familiar, like some of the "excuses" many of us have used but in Paul's case they are not excuses. Instead Paul is telling us it's the sinful nature living in us that we have to learn to control and overcome. Now in Romans 7:25 he tells us, "Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord."

Let's look now to Galatians 3:19 (AMP), "And all who depend on the Law (who are seeking to be justified by the obedience to law of rituals) are under a curse and doomed to disappointment and destruction, for it is written in the Scriptures, Cursed be everyone who does not continue to abide (live and remain) by all of the precepts and commands written in the Book of Law and practice them." Right here I see that when I've broken one law I am now under the curses of the Law and doomed to disappointment due to the fact that I CAN NEVER fulfill the requirements the Law has placed before me. At that point one might think, "What's the use?" If that is you keep coming because you will see that following Jesus is worth every second of the journey. A few paragraphs above I mentioned a subject concerning being "married, divorced, etc." Again I'm going to use the words of the Apostle Paul to help us better understand law from grace. In Romans 7:1-3 (AMP), "Do you not know, brethren - for I am speaking to men who are acquainted with the Law – that legal claims have power over a person only for as long as he is alive. 2) For (instance) a married woman is bound by law to her husband as long as he lives; but if her husband dies, she is loosed and discharged from the law concerning her husband. 3) Accordingly, she will be held an adulteress if she unites herself to another man while her husband lives. But if her husband dies, the marriage law no longer is binding on her (she is free from that law); and if she unites herself to another man, she is not an adulteress." Praise God! Did you just see what Paul said? Remember earlier where I mentioned the things I was being taught in my youth? Here they are in the New Testament.

As we continue on notice the word "Likewise" as light is being shed between the first three Scriptures (Law) and the message through Christ (grace). Romans 7:4 (AMP) explains, "Likewise, my brethren, you have undergone death as to the Law through the (crucified) body of Christ, so that you may belong to Another, to Him Who was raised from the dead in order that we may bear fruit for God." Simply put, when you made Jesus the Lord of your life you are now dead to law that you might now be married to Jesus because He is the Husband in reference here. Jesus has completed the requirements of the Law. It is NOTHING we could EVER do so this DOES NOT MEAN that His grace is a license to sin more! (Romans 7:7-8) It just keeps getting better folks so let's read on. Romans 7:5 (AMP) reads, "When we were living in the flesh (mere physical lives), the sinful passions that were awakened and aroused up by (what) the Law (makes sin) were constantly operating in our natural powers (in our bodily organs, in the sensitive appetites and wills of the flesh), so that we bore fruit for death." Here the word flesh, in the Strong's Concordance is the Greek word, #4561, (sarx), and is referring to our human nature which we all know is always at war with the Spirit. Now in Romans 7:6 (AMP) we see, "But now we are discharged from the Law and have terminated all intercourse with it, having died to what once restrained and held us captive. So now we serve not under (obedience to) the old code of written regulations, but (under obedience to the promptings) of the Spirit in newness (of life)."

Let me remind you that the Old Covenant (Law), revealed through Moses, was only for the Jews and not the Gentiles. The New Covenant (Grace), brought by Jesus, was not only to redeem those under the Law but also for the purpose of saving the Gentiles (us) as well. Jesus didn't pay the high price that He did to leave any of us under the Law. The only way you ... continued on page 9

I'm enclosing a story Father God gave me while I was fasting for a guy who was looking at the death penalty. I know that God crossed the two of our paths and he came to receive Christ before I was sent to prison. The details up until he met the Lawyer were from this new brother in Christ. The rest of this is the way God revealed the story to me. God revealed to me that this could be for ALL those that believe and receive Jesus!

I was arrested and incarcerated for the following crimes; three counts of murder, three counts of home invasion, one count of prohibited possessor, one count of negligent homicide and ten counts of possession of a dangerous drug with the intent to distribute.

I sit in my cell and as time goes by and as my mind clears the actions of my choices sets in. My guilt racks my body like a freight train. I realize that I have taken life, destroyed homes; pushed poison and perpetuated HATE and DISCONTENT to everyone I came in contact with. I once was the one that caused hopelessness in the lives of the innocent; now hopelessness overtakes me. I am fatigued and weak, not able to stand the man that I am; a bringer of destruction and death. Now, from guilt and shame I long for that same death and destruction to be brought to me. There seems to be no way out. I was caught red handed at the scene and my DNA ties me to all my charges. I have no hope. My cellmate says they most likely will give me a Letter of death.

I met with my Lawyer, he introduced himself and said hello. We went over the specifics of my case and he was brutally honest. He told me that the evidence is so concrete that there's no chance of a good trial. He told me my Judge is a very stem but just Judge. He told me that He has been sitting on the bench longer than I have been alive and He is totally against the shedding of innocent blood. He then proceeded to tell me about the prosecutor, that he is totally unforgiving and that he is working night and day to convict me. He added that he was using all of my prior convictions and anything else he could use to bring accusations against me to sway the Judge into believing that I'm an evil man. Then He told me, "He's pushing for the death penalty."

At this point I'm devastated. My Lawyer looked at me and said, "The Judge respects Me. Would you like Me to ask Him if He will consider a plea?" I thought for a moment that anything is better than that Letter. I told Him that I trusted Him and for Him to use His best judgment. Then I realized I just told Him that I trusted Him with my life and I don't even know Him, and then I thought their trying to give me this Letter.

My court date was in three weeks. As I sat in my cell all of the bad things I'd ever done flooded my mind. Again the guilt and the shame racked my body as physical fatigue overtook me. I can no longer stand on my own two feet. I am suicidal, a broken man with no hope. I have no family, no one cares.

One week before my court date and my Lawyer comes to visit. He said hello as I sit down and goes on to say, "There have been some developments in your case. The Judge will consider a plea of life without parole, but that means you will have to plead guilty to all the charges and take responsibility for all your actions before the Judge." He went on to say, "I will take responsibility for your actions before the Judge. And I'll write up in the plea that anything in the past shall be dismissed without prejudice, but it's up to the Judge." He added that the prosecutor was pushing for the death penalty at all cost.

The night before court while I was in my cell asleep I saw the brightest light I've ever seen. A voice called out to me and said, "Sign the plea; it's your only hope." At that moment I was flooded with peace. I was no longer scared and I no longer felt hopeless. I've never known or talked to God before but I do remember hearing about Him and then it hit me; God IS REAL and if this is what it feels like to know God I will sign whatever plea is set before me, and I did.

The next day at court, my sentencing, I was calm with no worry. I was ready to take responsibility for my actions. Then my name was called. The Judge asks me, "Did you knowingly and intelligently sign this plea?" I said, "Yes, Your Honor." He asked, "Did the prosecutor make you any promises?" "No Sir. I'm guilty as charged," I replied. He continued, "I accept your plea. All past charges are dropped and cannot be brought back up. I sentence you to life. But, because you were honest and took responsibility for your actions I can see you're a changed man. I Am suspending your incarceration." The prosecutor screamed, "NO!" as the Judge told him to be quiet. Then the Judge turned to me and said, "You will be released



from custody. See that you live a life of honor, integrity and truth. You've been given a second chance at life, don't take it for granted." As He slammed His gavel down He said one last thing, "Court dismissed!"

Foot's Bible Study Notes

1 Samuel 18:5-19:24

Jealousy may not seem to be a major sin, but in reality, it is one step short of murder. Jealousy starts as you resent a rival, it leads to you wishing he or she were removed. Then it manifests itself in your seeking ways to harm that person in word or action. Beware of letting jealousy get a foothold in your life. (18:8)

Don't allow popularity to twist your perception of your own importance. It's comparatively easy to be humble when you're not on center stage, but how will you react to praise and honor? (18:15-18)

John 8:31:59

Jesus Himself is the Truth that sets us free. (8:36) He is the source of truth, the perfect standard of what is right. He frees us from the consequences of sin, from self-deception, and from the deception of satan. He shows us clearly the way to eternal life with God. Thus, Jesus does not give us freedom to do what we want, but freedom to follow God. As we seek to serve God, Jesus' perfect truth frees us to be all that God meant us to be. (8:32)

When Jesus says those who obey won't die, He is talking about spiritual death. Even physical death, however, will eventually be overcome. Those who follow Christ will be raised to live eternally with Him. (8:51)

Psalm 112:1-10

We all want to live without fear, our heroes are fearless people who take on all dangers and overcome them. The psalmist teaches us that fear of God can lead to fearless life. To fear God means to respect and revere Him as the Almighty Lord. When we trust God completely to take care of us, we will find that our other fears – even of death itself – will subside. (112:7-8)

Proverbs 15:11-14

If the Lord's knowledge goes as far as the depths of death and destruction, surely He would know every nook and cranny of the human heart. Hence, He knows all about us, we cannot hide anything from Jesus Christ. Is your eternal life worth playing a game of cat and mouse or hide and seek with the Lord? Mine's not. BELIEVE – Part I By Bob Small – Introduction by Wade Anderson

Introduction: Let me introduce Bob Small to you all. Over six years ago, we met at a Patricia King prophetic conference in Phoenix. He was here from Canada. It was shortly after the conference began that we stumbled onto each other. Every day we were there, the Holy Spirit seemed to draw us to praise and worship, even share meals together. We agreed to stay in contact and we have done just that. A few months ago, we were speaking together on the phone, when a message of "Believe" became the topic. I asked Bob to pray about it, and then follow what the Spirit of God led him to do. Here are the results and it will be a three part series. I can't express enough how important it is to have relationships with other brothers and sisters in the Lord, even long distance. I know that this is just the beginning of the things God is going to use our relationship with Him to accomplish for His Glory!!

Do you realize everyone believes in something? Every person has a belief system that shapes who they are and where they end up in life. Often it comes from the environment we grew up in or an event, good or bad, that happened to us that dramatically impacted our lives. Sometimes we can be forced into a belief system that we don't really feel is true, don't like or feel there is a better way to live. Believing starts with thoughts and ideas in our head. In our culture today, technology and media bombard us with thoughts, ideas, commercials, TV shows, movies, billboards, internet, Facebook ... on and on with images and ideas of what we should believe in and become. Free choice and independence to go and do what we feel is right, relieves and avoids pain and helps us feel good, we believe. Generally we are a self-centred culture.

From the seed of a thought/ idea in our mind we accept or reject it. If accepted we let it grow inside our mind until we take action upon it. We believe it in our mind to the point we let it become part of our life and start taking action on that belief. As it does, the belief is shifted from our heads to our hearts and it starts shaping our life. This is where the true belief in a person is. You can have a thought or an idea in your mind you accept as true but until it moves into the action of your life the belief is not alive in your life. It is not in your heart. Ultimately, we have choice of all thoughts and ideas as to which ones we want to become. The root of our core belief system revolves around our inner security, or lack of inner security.

What is your core belief system? Maybe it is that you need to be in a gang/club to be accepted or feel protected. Maybe you were abandoned as a child and believe no one loves you and isolate yourself, trust no one and can never hold a stable job. Maybe for various reasons you feel inferior and insecure and turn to alcohol or drugs to help you fit into your surroundings. Briefly, mine was the latter. I used alcohol and drugs to help me fit in. I found a lifestyle of fun and excitement for awhile but eventually I became dependant to them and they robbed me of relationships, jobs, money and all material things in my life. More importantly they robbed me of hope, peace and the will to live. I harboured anger and bitterness and trusted no one in this world. I found myself homeless and involved with gangs to survive. My belief system was a lie and failed me. As much as I wanted it changed it had entrenched itself in my life and on my own I could not change it. After being dead in every way but physical and full of anguish, bewilderment and pain I cried out from the depth of my soul "**HELP!**"

That cry changed my belief system and ultimately my life. I had always believed in a God, as I was raised in a religious setting. We went to church every Sunday, attended Sunday school and I hated every minute of the experience. I remember the hard pews and feeling bored; there was no life in it. From that I had formed a belief that church was for weak people and thought myself as being independent and was responsible for making my own way. I always believed God existed but saw Him as being somewhere else, far away. As tragedy occurred in our family, it solidified this belief and became my core belief to which I lived by. In the end this belief proved to be a lie. I was no longer secure and all of the fun had long past. The lifestyle was about trying to kill the pain and survive through life.

After the cry for help God started revealing that He was real to me. Through circumstances, He was getting me out of the situation I was in; there were people in the right place at the right time. I was lead into a church that was Spirit filled and immediately I started experiencing a God that I know without a doubt lives with us and loves us all.

I am in the county jail right now and I would like to thank you for your ministry. A friend here gave me your May 2013 issue and I loved it, thank you again. Now I guess I will tell you a little about myself. I will start right after high school.

Well, I didn't listen to my parents and keep my grades up or I might have gotten a sport scholarship, instead, I enlisted in the Army. During the first six months of my enlistment, I would assist the chaplain by teaching classes and even saying a few verses in front of the congregation. Before too long the chaplain said to me, "I believe you should become a chaplain yourself and I can make this happen for you." My calling, but I ignored it and stated to him, "No, I'm not worthy and I want to go into the Special Forces." I now believe that He was calling me in to service for Him.

As the years went by in the Army, I served in the 82nd Airborne, 2nd Ranger Battalion, the Special forces and I loved it! Before long I came to another crossroad if you will; either reenlist or take a job making great money with the Feds. I took the job with the Feds and became a Federal Agent. It was during this time that I met my Bathsheba. I didn't come to know all of the facts until after we were married. My new wife had been lying to me. She was already married and still living with that husband while she was seeing me. I was also active at this time in church teaching and ministering.

Soon after this we left that area and moved to Buckeye, Arizona and I took a job as a police officer there and the church attendance stopped. During my law enforcement career, I became SWAT and K-9. From there I became a K-9 trainer and owned some German Sheppards where I even made this a small business. At the same time, I had my own small school where I was a martial arts instructor and I taught out of a church gym. I got out of law enforcement because I was tired of the politics.

From there I had some other options. I could either take a job back in the Army being a chaplain, chaplain's assistant or take a job making six figures plus bonuses. This Army job would also be a K-9 trainer in Iraq with the United States State Department. By the way, the dogs I was training now were bomb detection dogs. Can you guess which job I accepted? I took the K-9 job. I completed all of the training in Florida and was preparing to fly out to Iraq. I received a knock on my hotel door at 6:30 a.m. June 22, 2011 and I was arrested for the very first time in my life. Since then I've been sitting in the county jail awaiting trial. I will NOT plea out to something that I didn't do! I am looking at 115 years plus if I am convicted. Since then my wife has divorced me and by the way, I believe that's a blessing.

During my time here in the county jail my walk with my Lord and Savior has grown even closer. I know for the first time in my life that Jesus is preparing a place for me in heaven. Thanks to the Lord that after a year of petitions, I was able to get a worship service going on here in this unit. I've helped other inmates sign up for Bible correspondence courses and I'm even taking college courses to receive a ministry degree someday. Before I was arrested I was three classes shy of an associate's degree in criminal justice. I've received my calling and His will be done (*Jeremiah 29:11*) right here where I sit today. Today I preach and teach the Word of God right here in the county jail. The Lord has truly blessed me! I only wish that I would have truly given myself to Christ a long time ago but I needed to be at the end of me, I guess. I hope that someday I will be able to assist your ministry in some way. No matter what happens I will live in peace and do the Father's work until I die ...C.S. (County Jail)

He stopped and began breaking down in tears. In his crying he told me that he used to go to church, believed in God but was not living it now. He said that he ran a business that was in trouble, his wife was getting ready to leave and he was not connected with his kids. The third man was in a coffee shop. As I sat across from him I learned through over hearing his phone conversations that he was successful in running a computer business, had lots of material things in his life and had some friends. But there was a pride, coldness and loneliness to him. Against my own feelings I felt God wanting me to approach him so I did. His response was that he was an atheist and didn't believe in God. A week later after forgetting all about this day a small voice came to me, reminding me of the three men and asked, "Of the three men who truly was homeless?"

You see it is not about whom we are in this world, what we have or the friends we have, but IT IS about believing in something that gives us true security and peace. Nothing of this world will do that!! In fact, the voice of this world will bring death as it did to Adam and Eve. But believing in Jesus and learning Who God is will bring the true life we all are seeking, whether we know it or not.
