Regular Meeting ----- August 1, 1989

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. at the District office. Board members present were Gary Wilson and John Groo.

Special Service District members present were Dan Holyoak, George White, Gary Wilson, D. L. Taylor and Bill McDougald.

Others present were Ferne Mullen, Roberta Highland and Dale Pierson.

Roberta read the minutes of the meetings of July MINUTES 11, 14, & 25, 1989. After calling for corrections or additions, George mentioned the revision to \$20. per AF for pumping costs should be reflected in the minutes of July 26, 1989. The Chair declared the minutes approved as revised.

had responded, 53 responded yes. we are pumping to 51% of the customers. The costs are averaging about \$20.50 per AF. Dale reported some water has gone into the reservoir, and we are delivering that water to the upper users. The totalizer has quit working so we do not know exactly how much. Farnsworth has asked about turning his mesa water into the reservoir and taking it below. George asked if we charge a storage fee, and store Farnsworth's mesa water. It was asked if Tangren and Farnsworth are paying a pumping charge along with other customers. This was discussed, and it was agreed they should share in these pumping costs.

Dale was asked to contact Farnsworth about fees for storage

of his mesa water.

Dale reported the survey indicates 71 customers IRRIGATION SURCHARGE SURVEY RETURN

The H & D Lance wells are now electrically ready, HOWARD & but the saddles have not arrived. Those wells should be DELOY LANCE ready to be turned on by Wednesday. They are metered, so we WELLS will know what they are delivering.

The irrigation turn system seems to be working. The meters have been read, customers who have not returned REPORT their option questionaire have been cut off, but we are still playing by ear. When the hay cutting is over, we may have low pressure problems again.

Dale reported he has checked with the Governor's DROUGHT staff, and the disaster fund has been prioritized to culi- DISASTER nary systems, and there is to be no further disaster funds.

POSSIBLE RELIEF

D. L. reported he had talked with Robertson about RON ROBERTSON the Chapman well, Ron now has stated he is ready to go WELL

ahead with the sale of his well along the lines proposed, a road to the property, and water and sewer connections.

The Betty Schumaker Well #1 was discussed, and B.S. #1 WELL Gary suggested we budget to re-drill that well.

It was reported the terms of D. L. Taylor and Gary DIRECTOR Wilson will expire September 9, 1989. Bill McDougald moved TERMS OF the District request the County Commissioners to re-appoint OFFICE D. L. Taylor and Gary Wilson to another term in office. John Groo seconded. MOTION CARRIED.
