

CLIFFORD TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. _____

PROVIDING FOR COOPERATIVE POLICE SERVICE AND
PROTECTION WITH ADJACENT TOWNSHIP OF GREENFIELD,
LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

In order to provide increased police protection and greater efficiency in law enforcement in the Township of Clifford, the Board of Supervisors hereby ordain and enact as follows:

1. The duly appointed police officers of the Township of Greenfield, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania, are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into the territorial limits of the Township of Clifford when requested by the Clifford Township Police Department, and exercise all the powers and authority conferred by law on the duly appointed police officers and constables of a second class township, while such police officers are within the territorial boundries of the Township of Clifford.

2. The duly appointed police officers of the aforesaid Township entering into the Township of Clifford for the purpose of providing police service, and in the exercise of police authority to arrest, when a member of the Clifford Township Police Department is not present, shall, within twenty-four (24) hours from the date and time of such police activity, submit to the Clifford Township Police Department a written report of the activity.

4. The duly appointed police officers of the Township of Greenfield are empowered to enter into the Township of Clifford for the purpose set forth in this Cooperative Police Service Ordinance, when so authorized as set forth in Section 5 of this Ordinance.

5. This Ordinance shall become effective as to the aforesaid Township at such time as they adopt similar ordinance granting like powers to members of the Clifford Township Police Department, and may be terminated by the Clifford Township thirty (30) days notice being given to Greenfield Township.
