The Leadership Board meets on the third Thursday of the month at 5:30 pm. The next meeting will be March 16. All church members are welcome to attend.






Book Club is a subsidiary of Saints Alive! We meet the second Thursday of the month at a members home or a local Restaurant.

Tailgater Update



Early Response Teams (ERTs) typically provide assistance after the "first responders" and before recovery and rebuilding. ERTs are assigned various tasks; usually relating to safety, mitigation of further damage to property, and cleanup tasks to assist the homeowner in preparation for rebuild. ERTs also sometimes serve in Local Assistance Centers providing comfort and items such as wildfire buckets to survivors. Always being the Caring Christian Presence! Minimum age is 18 years.
