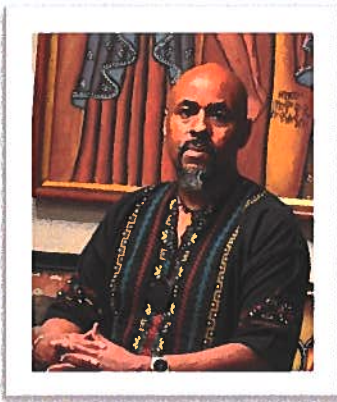

Dr. Herman "Skip" Mason, Jr.

Dr. Herman "Skip" Mason, Jr. is the senior pastor of Historic "Mother" Trinity Christian Methodist Episcopal Church in Augusta, Georgia. He is a native of Atlanta and a 1980 graduate of D.M. Therrell High School. He completed his undergraduate studies at Morris Brown College in 1984 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Communications. Dr. Mason attended Atlanta University (now Clark Atlanta University) and received a Master of Library Science Degree with a concentration in African-American history. He matriculated at the Phillips School of Theology at the Interdenominational Theological Center where he obtained Master of Divinity Degree and the Doctor of Ministry degree respectively. His dissertation "Black Ancestors Matters: Ancestral Memory, Genealogy and DNA in the African-American Church" is in preparation for publication.

Dr. Mason has served as professor of history, college archivist, director and dean of students at both Morris Brown College (1998-2003) and Morehouse College (1992-1998;2003-2012) in Atlanta, Georgia. Currently, he is the Director of the Voorhees College Library and Assistant Professor of African-American History and Religion.

Dr. Mason is the author of numerous books on the history of African Americans experience in Atlanta, Georgia and the South including **Going Against The Wind: A Pictorial History of African-Americans in Atlanta; Black Atlanta in the Roaring Twenties, Black Life in DeKalb County, African American Life in East Point, Georgia; Black Life in Jacksonville, Florida; The History of African Americans in Washington, Georgia; The Talented Tenth: The Founders and Presidents of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity** to name a few. Mason has also curated major exhibitions (Centennial Exhibition of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity in Washington, D.C. 2006, Crowns and Gowns: The Legacy of the Black College Homecoming Queen; Hidden Treasures: African American Photographer in Atlanta and the History of the Phillips School of Theology. He has served as a historical consultant on numerous PBS and Georgia Public Broadcast documentaries. He is a sought lecturer of African American Genealogy, DNA and Family History research.

Dr. Mason served as the 33rd General President of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity and on the National Board of Directors of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Foundation in Washington, D.C. He is a member of numerous social and civic organization including the Prince Hall Masonic Organization.

Dr. Mason has served as the pastor of the following churches: St. James C.M.E. Church/ Washington, Georgia; Greater Hopewell/Atlanta and St. Paul/Athens. He has served as pastor of Trinity since 2012. Mason serves as the Chair of the Georgia North Joint Board of Finance and on the Archives Commission of the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church.

In his spare time, he enjoys reading, traveling, collecting black memorabilia and photographs, listening to music, and researching his family history. Lastly, Dr. Mason is the father of two wonderful teen-aged children Jewel (age 18) and Jodari (age 16). He gives thanks to God for his journey and is grateful to know that God is not through with him yet.
