About Posse Foundation

Every year, The Posse Foundation works closely with high schools to recruit Posse Scholars. **Each Posse Scholar receives a four-year, full-tuition scholarship to attend one of the Posse's partner colleges or universities. In Atlanta, Posse ATL has granted 60 students a scholarship for four years to their 6 partner institutions.** If you are interested in being nominated by your high school and demonstrate leadership and academic potential, early decision commitment, willingness to study out of state please submit this scholarship application no later than **Monday, July 1, 2019 to Mrs. Elisa Turner, Community Partner.**

The **initial nomination round includes** a review of the application by the SOAR organization Counselors in order to select the top five nominees for the Posse Scholarship Foundation – POSSE Atlanta chapter. If you are selected as a nominee, you will be contacted by the end of the school year. If selected, your nomination status will be sent to the Posse Foundation – POSSE Atlanta Chapter and you will be required to attend a three-hour interview (DAP) with over 100 students with POSSE ATL and continue with the second round if you qualify. The first interview (DAP) process includes ranking your top three colleges from the partner institutions listed below, conversations about leadership, and many other aspects. While, the Posse Foundation- POSSE ATL Chapter does their best to find the best match, it is not guaranteed that you will be matched with your first-choice college. If selected as a Posse Scholar, you will be applying to one of the colleges listed below under their binding **Early Decision agreement**, which means you must commit to attend and cannot apply to other colleges with Early Decision.

- Boston University – Boston, MA
- Brandeis University – Waltham, MA
- The George Washington University- Washington, DC
- The College of Wooster – Wooster, OH
- Texas A & M University – College Station, Texas



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Short Answers and Essay

1. 5. How do you typically spend your day afterschool? What do you do when you get home? (i.e. work, volunteer, caring for siblings, etc.)
6. Provide a resume, transcript, 1 page essay on "What Servant Leadership Mean To Me" and test scores if applicable.
