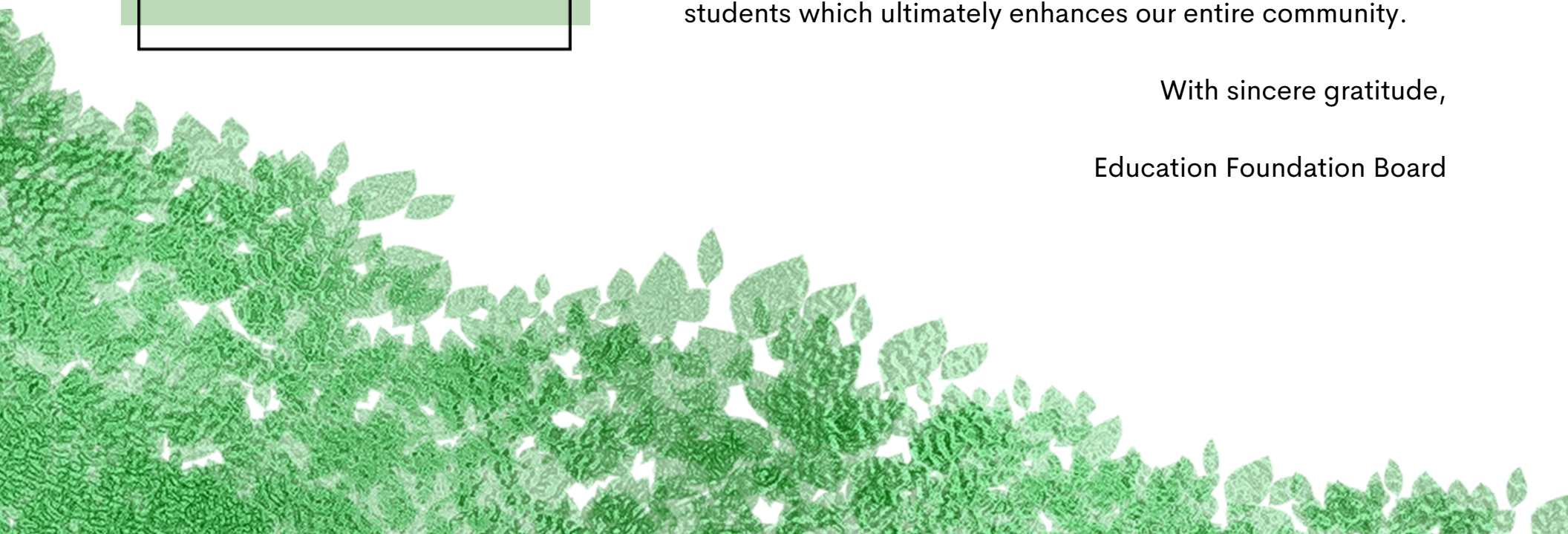
Dear Lincoln County R-III Community,

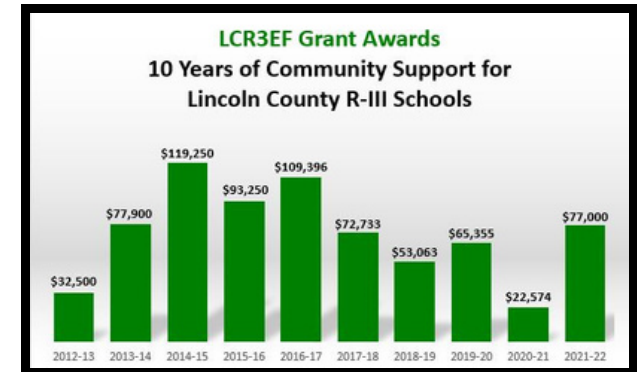
In 2012, the Lincoln County R-III Education Foundation was established to provide supplemental funds for educational programs, technology, and activities for the R3 School District.

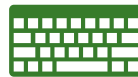

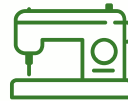

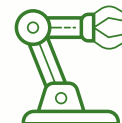

2021 Grants Help Engage Students

During the 2021 grant season, Ms. Pletcher received virtual reality viewers for her French students. Her students enjoyed using them to view Brive, the town in France where their pen pals live. After viewing Brive, the class spoke in French and shared what they experienced.



Ms. Akins was awarded a 2021 grant for writing tablets which were utilized in her Pre-K classroom during the 2021-22 school year. When asked about her grant, Ms. Akins responded "Last year, we did a lot of learning on our individual whiteboards. We would write letters, numbers, draw...we used it for everything and the students loved them. As teachers, we decided we wanted something else to use that would continue to help them love to learn." The teachers researched the writing tablets and submitted a grant application to LCR3EF requesting funding for them. After the grant was awarded and the students began using the tablets, Ms. Akins provided the following update "We can't tell you how excited our kids were when we surprised them with the boards and showed them how to use them. They were in awe and called them "Magic Boards." This year we have already used them so much. Our students even use them during free play where they work on their social skills as they play. We are in awe when they choose the magic boards because it means they are wanting to practice their letters, numbers and draw as a choice and that too us makes our hearts happy."

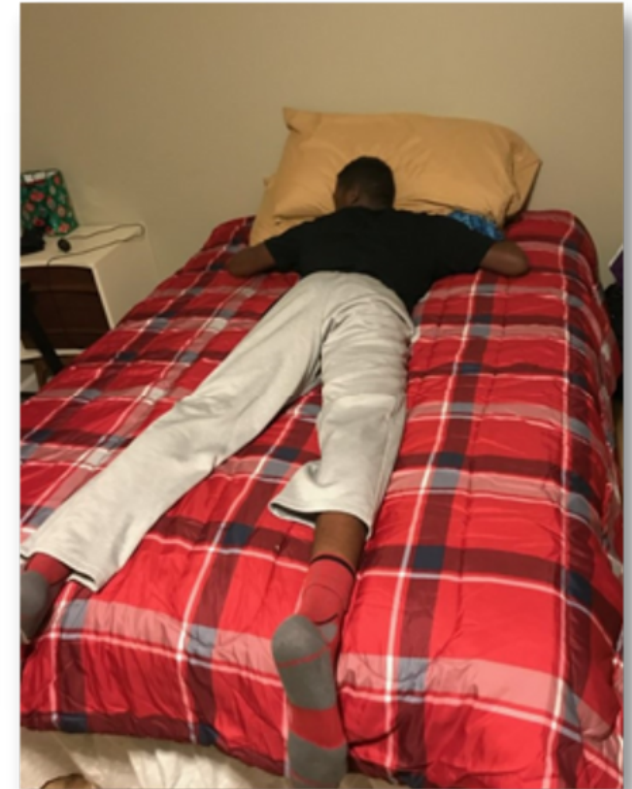
