www.simplygarnett.com or surveys can be picked up at City Hall, or if you wish staff from the City of Garnett can enter the home and check the pipes for you. City staff will be checking the water meter for each property both inside and outside the meter pit. This survey is needed for each resident as well as all Businesses within the City.

The EPA is collecting data nationwide in order to determine the need of each community within the United States from delivery of lead into water distribution systems and potential products of purchase.

The City of Garnett lead level is well within regulation standards as per state regulations. Lead comes from many areas, entering a home or system through the metals used in production of faucets for bathrooms, kitchens and other distribution products. This survey will aid in the support of changing products to be produced with material healthy for Communities.
