September Lunch Summary

Ninety-four people attended the September SAABE lunch meeting where SAABE members opened up their wallets for families that were affected by Hurricane Ike. Two truckloads of supplies and \$222 were contributed to these families.

Pat Murray with Phillips Lighting came from Houston (in the midst of dealing with Ike) to share some important information about everything lighting.

We all learned the shocking statistics of lighting usage in the U.S. compared to other nations. As a country, we use 24% of our electricity for lighting, compared to 6% in Japan. To help combat this, Phillips has introduced their brand of T8 bulbs, the Alto II. The Alto II bulbs contain only 1.7 mg of mercury, are better for the environment and help reduce operating costs. Because of the longer life of the bulbs (67% longer), there are less labor costs dealing with re-lamping, and there is less money spent on recycling. And, because Phillips believes so strongly in this product, the bulbs have a 48 month warranty.

Pat also shared information about the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007. This Act took effect on January 1st of this year and prohibits the manufacture of certain reflector style incandescent lamps.




