- Entry fee for the Sunday Show is \$15 per head
- Sunday show will include swine sheep, meat goats and beef
- There will be NO showmanship on Sunday
- If there are scratches or additional animals added for the Sunday show, please let Jackie Buckley know by 5:00pm Saturday.

- Showmanship will be judged during the judging, call backs may or may not be held
