Let's come together as a club to make a meaningful impact — both on and off the course.


• Pace of Play & Check-In: Let's continue to respect our fellow members by arriving early, checking in promptly, and keeping pace on the course.

Unfortunately, our second EPMC tournament of the new season was rained out. Our last rainout was January 2023, so we've been lucky for the last few years. We're pleased to share, however, that the Individual Low Net tournament had 94 players registered, 44 special requests in Golf Genius, and 13 players taking advantage of Zelle pre-



pay. All Zelle payments have been fully reimbursed.

Our next event is the always-popular **4-Club Red Tees Tournament** on **December 13th**. Keep an eye out for the Golf Genius signup invitation—spots fill quickly, so register early. Player roster will be confirmed via email on **Wednesday**, **December 10th**, with tee times and pairings released on **Friday**, **December 12th**.

This is an **individual format**, and each player must sign up through Golf Genius. When registration opens, please follow these simple steps:

Step 1: In the invitation email, navigate to the bottom and confirm your status by selecting **Playing** or **Not Playing**.

Step 2: If needed, you may send a message to the tournament manager with any special requests (tee time or pairing preferences). We will do our best to accommodate.

Step 3: Click **Send** to finalize your response.

The Golf Genius tee sheet will automatically populate with confirmed players. As always, we will monitor signups closely and communicate any issues. Registered players should receive an automated confirmation email from Golf Genius.

Skins News

As we move into winter, we all know that means rain and weather issues.

One big issue I see as the course softens up are those members that continue to drive their carts right down the middle of fairways. We should all be stewards of our home course.



To protect the course, we suggest following a couple of easy to do rules.

- Approach the location of your ball from the rough and then drive 90 degrees across the fairway to get to it
- 2. Stay in the marked areas and off softer areas of the course
- 3. Be cognizant of the conditions you leave the course behind you for other members and the public

A second issue is how the weather causes cancelations or the belief a round has been canceled because it is raining where you live.

What we ask of our members is this:

- If you sign up for the skins game, be patient and we will let you know if the game is canceled the day before as we usually find out from the course
- Show up to the course if you haven't heard it has been canceled. From experience, we know the weather in Orange Country, or Riverside does not reflect the weather in Chino
- Call the course before you leave the house or reach out to the skins game coordinator to verify, rather than just not show up

For those that have been around long enough, we have seen instances when the day begins with sun and ends with rain and I know of at least two instances where a tournament was canceled over the threat of weather and the day turned out perfect with no rain and lots of sunshine.

Also, because of the location of the course and unfavorable weather conditions, we can get fog from time to time. This WILL slow the game down a bit as the first few groups have a much tougher time following their shots until the fog burns off.

Be patient and if you are the group in front, let the group behind you know that you will either yell back when everyone is clear, or work out some sort of notification to ensure we aren't hitting into the group in front of you.

Zelle Instructions

Hello Fellow Golfers,

Thank you to everyone who has been using Zelle for payments — it greatly simplifies the check-in process. I do have a couple of requests to help keep everything running smoothly:



• Please include your full name and the tournament month in the Zelle payment comment. Example: "Wayne Nichols for November Tournament."

Some payments come through under a spouse's or another person's name, which makes it difficult to identify who the payment is for. Using the tournament month also helps us find your payment quickly.

- All Zelle payments must be submitted by 5:00 PM on the Friday before the tournament. Payments cannot be accepted at the check-in table on tournament day.
- You must still check in at the table even if you paid through Zelle.
 This is the only way for us to confirm your attendance.

Thank you again. For those who paid for the November tournament, I sent refunds via Zelle on Saturday.

Lodging will be at the Santa Fe Station Hotel and Casino. You are responsible for reserving and paying for your room online at El Prado Mens Golf Club Offer ACIEPMC or calling (702) 658-4900. Our group rates are Wed/Thu \$79, Fri/Sat \$131; plus 13% tax and \$25.99 resort fee.

Golf Thursday June 4 - <u>Painted Desert</u>, tee times starting at 10:40 AM - Skins game with gross and net skins, closest; and single low gross/net. One or two flights based on size of field.

Golf Friday June 5 - <u>Highland Falls</u> 7:00 AM Shotgun –Skins game with 2-3 flights of gross & net skins, closest; and blind draw partner best ball.

Golf Saturday June 6 - Palm Valley 7:00 AM Shotgun Individual Low Net Tournament paying 30% of field, gross skins, closest.

Saturday June 6 Awards Dinner at the resort. Dinner Buffet from 6:00 to 9:00 PM. Dinner starts at 6:30 PM and is included for golfers. Guests are \$60.

Guests are welcome if space is available at the deadline. Guests play to GHIN LI or adjusted as determined by Handicap Committee in prior Getaway performances. If no GHIN handicap, guests will play to 0 handicap. Guests will be in on skins, closest, and Friday two-man blind draw, and Thursday low net/gross; but are NOT in Saturday's ILN tournament. If we have enough guests, there will be a separate tournament pot for guests on Saturday. For golf questions, contact Gary Abbott or Mark Rief

Payment- Prices on the entry form include Golf, Saturday Dinner, and prize money. You are responsible for your lodging.
