<u>The TBLA Board of Directors</u> – The Board met on August 21 and further discussed details of a previously approved grant request to fund 13 boat ramp signs for Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries that will document creel limits for anglers and give a brief description of the TBLA Lunker Bass Program. Final sign design and number will be determined at the September Board meeting. The next TBLA Board meeting will be on Tuesday, September 18, at 6:30 p.m. at the Toledo Town SCOA building.
