A Note from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Liturgical celebrations are slowly opening to all. No more than 50 people can gather which we will reasonably respect. Physical distancing of 6 feet is still required.

Sunday masses will be offered at the same time as before; Saturday 5:30 pm, Sunday 9:00 am and 11:30 am.

Tuesday – Friday 9:00 am and Monday 6:00 pm. **All masses will be celebrated in the Church.**

Saint Olaf Website www.stolafut.org and SaintOlafut Facebook page has a sign-up list for those who wish to join for mass in the church on weekends since attendance is limited. You can also call the office at 801.295.3621 to sign up.

General absolution from Sunday obligation is still in effect so there is no sin for not attending mass physically. Everyone is encouraged to return to participation in the Holy Mass. However, the elderly and people with health problems or those afraid of the illness are advised to remain home and join spiritually. We will livestream the 11:30 Mass via Facebook – Andrzej Skrzypiec as well as post on YouTube – Saint Olaf Catholic Church.

Weekday participation at mass is another option especially for those who are not able to sign up for Sunday mass. We will also need volunteers to help disinfect the pews in the church after each mass. Please help.

Realizing the existing threat, we do not want to be reckless but assume the dutiful worship in a safe and responsible manner. The restrictions of not receiving communion from the Chalice and not on the tongue are still in effect.

Thank you for your cooperation and support, both spiritual and financial of Saint Olaf Parish at this difficult time.

Spiritual Adoption

Month 2-Developing Baby-"I'm dancing!"

Your baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby-teeth buds are present at 6 1/2 weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, your spiritually adopted baby grows and refines her body. But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a "fetus"-a Latin word meaning "little one". An ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip and jump-her first dance steps!
