Popular music styles people listen to today on their iPods, such as country and hip hop, are rooted in the music traditions of our state. In Carolina Music Ways' school show, *Carolina Live! - Our Musical History*, twelve outstanding North Carolina musicians pass along our state's outstanding musical heritage to young audiences.

The program highlights famous musicians from North Carolina and the social and cultural conditions which influenced their development. Artist's covered include: John Coltrane, Doc Watson, Blind Boy Fuller and the 5 Royale's.

Seven genres of music are covered including Old Time, Blues, Moravian Music, Blue Grass, Jazz, Gospel and early R&B.
