

Appropriation Ordinance No, 772

An ordinance making appropriations from the various funds of the City of Garnett, Anderson County Kansas to pay the claims against said city.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Commissioners of the city of Garnett Anderson County Kansas.

Section One:- that there is hereby appropriated out of the following
