Thessalon First Nation is seeking four (4) Summer Day Camp Coordinators to promote healthier lifestyle choices through social, educational, and recreational activities to the children and youth of our community in a safe and nurturing environment..

The students will be under the direction of the Community Support Service Worker and the Health Director. The students will be assisting in the development, implementation, facilitation and evaluation of the summer day camp program and activities. The students will be required to develop and deliver programs which promote "FAMILY TOGETHERNESS" by creating a forum through which elders, parents, and children and youth communicate and interact with each other thus strengthening the bonds between family and community..

Duties and Responsibilities:

- To assist in developing, implementing and evaluating program and activities that meet the social, educational, recreational and health related needs of our children and youth;..
- To record the concerns and needs of the children and youth and report these in a timely manner;..
- To assist in designing and implementing programs which include parent/child/youth activities;..
- To encourage the children and youth to participate in community events;..
- Be a positive role model for the children and youth and community;..
- Work in preparation and /or during the Thessalon First Nation Pow Wow;..
- To submit daily journals;..
- To assist in developing a budget..

Qualifications:

- Must have a Social Insurance Number at the start date of employment;..
- Must be 15 years old at the start of employment;..
- Must be returning to school in September 2017;..
- Willing to work with children;..
- Ability to work constructively with youth and parents;..
- Ability to work in a team environment;..
- Must have interpersonal and positive communication skills;..
- Must lead a non-abusive, non-addictive lifestyle;..
- Must be able to travel and work flexible hours;..
- May be required to attend overnight camping trips;..
- Must be responsible and accountable;..
- First Aid/CPR and Food Safety Handling are mandatory (or be willing to be trained)...
