If you are before Thursday, please notify show management in advance so that we can be sure your stalls are ready for you.

All participating horses must be ASPC, ASPR or AMHR registered. All horses must be measured by the ASPC/AMHR steward or present a measurement slip documenting measurement by an official ASPC/AMHR steward within the last 60 days or a permanent measurement card for miniatures/ponies 6 years & older showing one measurement in year 2026. Stalls are \$100.00 for the weekend. Camper hook-ups are \$45.00 per night. Valid ASPC/AMHR registration, coggins (current within 1 year), health certificate within 45 days on out-of-state horses, youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided. General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2026 rules and regulations of the ASPC/AMHR.

All horses must be registered with the ASPC/AMHR.

This ASPC/AMHR show has one judge.

Awards will be given to 1st - 6th place. Championship ribbons will be awarded to Junior/Senior Champions, Grand Champions. High Point Awards will be given.

Welcome to the Expo at Glen Rose!

- Stabling:** Stalls are 10' x 10' with metal construction on concrete floors. No more than 2 horses per stall. Stallions 2 & older must be stalled separately. **NO BEDDING IS INCLUDED WITH THE STALLS & NO OUTSIDE BEDDING MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS.** Shavings are available for \$13.00. Showing off the trailer is permitted at a cost of \$50.00/horse per day. Please help keep the facility clean by putting trash in the barrels and manure in the dumpsters.
- Early Arrivals:** Exhibitors wishing to arrive before noon on Wednesday, 6/10 or layover on Sunday, 6/14 must make advance arrangements with Show Management and will be charged an **additional \$35 per stall per night.**
- Camping:** Full hookups with water and electric are \$45.00 per night. Payment is available on the entry forms.
- Food Stand:** A concession stand will be in operation Thursday - Sunday during show hours.
- Smoking:** No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.
- Dogs:** Dogs must be leashed or penned at all times and are NOT allowed in the concession area.

Expo at Glen Rose is located northeast of Glen Rose on Highway 67 (also known as Big Bend Trail). The Expo Center is on the north and may be entered off Bo Gibbs Blvd. which runs along the west side of the Expo Center.
- Challenged Exhibitors:** Challenged exhibitors are welcome to show. We would appreciate advance notice so appropriate arrangements can be made, if necessary. Please contact the show manager.
- Measurement:** All horses must be measured before entering the show ring. Horses will be measured in accordance with ASPC/AMHR rules beginning on Thursday, June 11 from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and resuming Friday through Saturday mornings at 7:00 a.m.
- Paperwork Requirements:** Copies of **registration papers must be included with entries.** Entries submitted without registration papers will be held pending receipt of same. Each horse must have a current coggins. Out-of-state should bring original negative coggins report (within one year) and health within 45 days.
- Youth Classes:** All youth must have an ASPC/AMHR Youth number to be considered for National awards or titles. Youth card applications are available at the Horse Show Office. Youth membership fee is free.
- Amateur Classes:** An ASPC/AMHR Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$30.00 if applied for at the show. Exhibitors must be a member of ASPC/AMHR and produce a membership card in order to apply for an amateur card. Applications are available from the Steward.

Driving Exhibitors:

There will be NO harnessing or hitching of miniatures in the main aisle from the warm-up arena to the Show Arena. Please harness in the side aisles and hitch up out in the warm-up arena. This is for safety and liability concerns. Thank you.

Evaluation Forms:

Judge and Steward evaluation forms will be available at the horse show office.

Liability Statement:

Southwestern Miniature Horse Club, its officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, driver, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at this show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY to this show or show grounds.

Show Policy:

Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The show manager will notify ASPC/AMHR of any such disqualification when the show results are reported.

Pre-Entries: Pre-Entries must be postmarked by May 9, 2026.

Added Classes: Added classes will be accepted up to four classes preceding the class to be entered.

Refunds:

The SWMHC will give a full refund if entries are cancelled in writing by the pre-entry closing date. If entries are cancelled in writing to the show manager and accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate of inability to show after the pre-entry closing date, but before the official start of the show (10:00 a.m. Thursday, May 2) all fees other than the stall and office fee will be refunded. After the official start of the show, there will be no refunds. **Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.**

Vendors:

The fee for commercial exhibitors is per day depending on the size of the booth and use of electricity. Tables and chairs are not provided. Contact Show Management for a contract. Rates are as follows:

- \$100 per day - 10 x 10 display or tent with electricity
- \$50 per day - 10 x 20 trailer with electricity
- \$75 per day - 10 x 40 trailer with electricity

Class Sponsorships:

The cost of sponsoring a regular class is \$10.00 and \$15.00 for a championship class. Sponsors will be acknowledged during the show and are welcomed to preent the ribbons for their classes.
