Reading Grade

All Cubs Reading Homework

Please remember that each school night, students are required to read for 15 to 20 minutes as part of their nightly homework.

Please use the Reading Eggs program to access the over 2,000 leveled readers from your child's Dashboard for this assignment. In addition you may use the books sent home in your child's binder or any books you wish. Please log each book read outside of the Reading Eggs program in your child's Reading Log found in the Reading section of your child's binder. This homework is 20% of your child's reading grade.

One Breath Boxes

Each evening your child should be practicing the words from his One Breath Box sheet. These words are drilled and tested weekly. Children progress up the Super Improver's "Look" chart as they master their Sight Words.

Spelling Words

Please practice reading and spelling these words at home. Spelling tests are held on Friday. One Breath Boxes are read throughout the week. The spelling and reading words are taken from Fry's first 100 high frequency words.
