PROGRESSING JUNIORS TOWARDS PAR OR BETTER ON AND OFF THE COURSE

The Roseville Golf Academy Junior Players Program uses the PGA Coach (ADM) Athletic Development Model framework to structure the program. It consists of Coaching, Playing, and Training programs and is designed to teach golfers to play the game from a hole out perspective. Each golfer will be assessed and issued a playing yardage that is designed to set appropriate objectives and challenge each student towards shooting par or better (score of 36) for 9 holes. As golfers achieve their scoring goals they progress back in yardage.

ACADEMY CLASSES

LEARN THE GAME

Juniors will learn the game in a weekly group class where our coach will progress students through the PGA Coach curriculum. Instruction is age appropriate for each age group. Skill challenges and competitions are used to reinforce instruction and prepare for on course play.
