The kids' events were great. We had over 600 kids on Saturday alone at the DFW Fishing in the City Casting booth outside of the convention Center. I want to thank all the club members who came out and volunteered in some way to promote fishing, including Jose L and Jose M Dominguez, James Garcia, Denise Davis, Sergio Gonzalez, and Joe Valerio who showed up on his birthday. If I missed you, thank you.

I am repeating the saltwater trips because I added a Triton trip in August AND I will soon open the trips to non-club members, so get your reservations in ASAP! ENOUGH SAID!

The saltwater schedule is out. I know there are some fishing Friday trips. This is because the 1½ and 2-day trips to take advantage of the BFT and doubling your limits while not staying out 2 days has become more popular. The big news from CCA right now is the California STAR Tournament. This Tournament is open to all California anglers at a very reasonable cost. Prizes are BIG! You can enter it by joining CCA and submitting an entry fee of only \$40. The Tournament runs all summer, Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day. No special boat required but the fish must be caught in California waters. With your entry they provide a special measuring device to each person. Eligible fish include:

- Saltwater Bass: Sand Bass, Calico Bass, Spotted Bay Bass (18 inches)
- California Halibut (28 inches)
- Yellowtail (36 inches)
- White Seabass (36 inches)
- Tuna: Bluefin, Yellowfin, Big Eye, Albacore (36 inches)

If you are going to one of the remaining shows you can take advantage of CCA's show package to renew your membership and sign up for the tournament at the same time! This Tournament is going to grow every year. This is a good time to get in at the beginning.

WHOPPER BOARD

It is your responsibility to make sure your fish is not disqualified. You must attend a Club freshwater event sometime during the year before November 1, 2024 to be eligible for any freshwater awards and you must attend a Club Saltwater Charter to be eligible for any saltwater awards. Remember Club events, both fresh and saltwater events fished by Club members, will count as double the points towards fresh and salt water angler of the year.

BIG BEAR LAKE WEEKEND

The weekend freshwater event at Big Bear Lake will be May 18th and 19th this year. Fishing will be both Saturday and Sunday. Each day will be a separate fishing event. Big Bear offers a variety of options, you can stay overnight or drive up one or both days. Accommodations are plentiful with advance reservations, including camping.

If you plan to bring your boat, be sure to check the regulations ahead of time. Big Bear Lake is open 24/7 year-round. While we've seen Dick Giuliani out on the lake in his boat during a blizzard, it is not recommended. Denise Davis has contacted the Lodge that many used last year and is waiting for an email with the Club's discounted rates. The Lodge is right on the lake and has docks. She will send out an email as soon as she gets the info. Let her know if you are interested.

Printed date is the date you will be fishing. Overnight trips load the night before. Full payment is required to reserve a spot. Prices subject to change if surcharge is charged to the Club. Departure times are tentative. They can change if everyone shows up.

I ask that younger more agile members and guests take the upper and lower bunks leaving the middle bunks to the more senior(age) members and guests.

Due to limited tackle box space, please consider bringing smaller or soft sided tackle box.

THE CHARTERMASTER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO OVERBOOK THE TRIPS BY ONE PERSON TO ENSURE THE CLUB DOES NOT LOSE MONEY.

Each trip stands alone. By that I mean each trip is a separate entity. You can write a check for multiple trips.

Bring your own bedding on trips. <u>Do not show up sick.</u> All Club members and guests are expected to abide by the Department of Fish and Wildlife rules.

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Membership is now open for 2024. If you have not yet paid dues, please get them in. They were due in January. Your dues must be paid in order to participate in the Whopper Board before you can submit any fish.

CLUB SHIRTS, POLOS AND JACKETS

You can order club clothing through Membership Chair Jose L Dominguez right now. We do not keep a stock of items but we do an order only once a year, so get your order to Jose ASAP. If you have items that require special separate shipping you will be responsible for shipping costs both ways.

Club hats are <u>WON</u> on Charters or Freshwater events and are not usually for sale.

We do not submit orders for one or two items. Our vendor is very busy and prefers larger orders. Once you submit an order it may take several months to get it in, because we wait until we have a decent sized order.

In the meantime, sign up for a Charter!

2024 Saltwater Charter Reservation Rules:

- 1. All club charters are available for reservation immediately.
- 2. Full amount will be required to confirm your reservation for any trip.

I will contact you prior to each trip. Each trip is best fishing available so don't call and ask.

- 4. No refunds until the Charter is full & the Club has been able to sell your reservation. The Club makes no guarantee that we will be able to fill your reservation once the Charter is full. Changes MUST go thru the Charter Master.
- 5. All charters are open to members and their invited guests.
- 6. If you need to cancel a charter reservation it must be done in <u>writing</u>, text or <u>email</u> to William Davis. Once you cancel you cannot change your mind and show up for the trip.

Policy for disabled members:

At the discretion of the Charter master, disabled individuals may be required to provide their own assistant for saltwater fishing events. The assistant will be counted as part of the full load, will be charged full fare, and must have a fishing license. As the purpose of the assistant is to assist the individual with a disability, the assistant may be allowed to fish when the individual with a disability is not fishing or has been deemed independent by the Charter master. If the assistant is not at the rail to assist, the disabled person may not fish. The disabled individual will provide their own gear/tackle or will be required to rent it. In the event that the assistant is not available at boarding time, the disabled person will not be allowed to board and they will not receive a refund unless the 2 spots are filled. If additional equipment is needed for accommodation, it must be cleared with the Charter master and boat before the reservation is accepted. For a free/reduced-fee California fishing license, Individuals with disabilities are encouraged to visit the Website https://wildlife.ca.gov/Licensing/Fishing#44521417-free--reduced-fee at least four months in advance of the trip to allow for processing time.
