Modern Foreign Languages

Through learning Spanish, our pupils develop positive attitudes and respect for languages, cultural differences and a tolerance of diversity within society.

Pupils will develop their language knowledge and skills to prepare them for life in modern Britain.

Spanish is taught as a discrete subject through a 30 minutes per week lesson throughout key stage 2 (years 3-6). Teaching and learning is on planned themes that change half-termly. There is also, a 'Spanish experience' once a year for all pupils in Years 3 - 6.
