

IDA KELTERBORN WARSON

1930 - 1996

Ida Kelterborn Warson, 66 of Clarkston, passed away Saturday, Sept. 28 at Wm. Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak, following a brief illness.

She was born April 11, 1930 in Lake Township, daughter of the late Lewis and Mary (Nagy) Kelterborn. She married Victor Warson on May 20, 1958 in Flint. He preceded her in death in 1969.
