Rodney Dillard

Rodney Dillard has had a long and varied career resulting so far in two Grammy Nominations; induction into the International Bluegrass Music Hall of Fame; a well-known acting stint on the Andy Griffith Show; many other movie, commercial and TV appearances; recipient of The Outstanding Missourian Award; and worldwide acclaim for his over 50 years of recording both traditional Bluegrass and his own brand of 'DILLARDGRASS'. Rodney Dillard is the founding member of the legendary group, 'THE DILLARDS' (aka the Darlings), who are seen nearly every day somewhere in the world, thanks to the enormous popularity of The ANDY GRIFFITH SHOW reruns.

By the late 1960's Rodney had transformed the Dillards into the driving force creating new sounds in the West Coast music environment. Later, called "The Father of Country Rock", Rodney was among the first Bluegrass musicians to "electrify" traditional Bluegrass instruments while also adding drums, steel guitar, and orchestra, and is credited with helping set the stage for the "Country Rock" movement and burgeoning progressive sounds of Bluegrass.
