The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting on Wednesday, January 22, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the High School Auditorium.

Mayor Lentz called the meeting to order.

Present: Mayor Lentz and Commissioners Forkenbrock, Edwards, Krug and Barton. Also present was Kim Clausen.

Marcus Lemonis was present and spoke to the citizens about the revitalization of Horton for nearly two hours while opening the floor to the audience for questions and answers. High School kids from USD 430 kicked off the presentation with a fun wrap and a gift basket for Mr. Lemonis. Marcus encouraged the city of Horton, and outlying cities to pull together and clean up the downtown area and the perimeter by cleaning up trash, washing windows, clearing brush, blacktopping and restriping streets, and planting flowers in the planters to make it look more inviting. He would like to see small businesses open up in the downtown area which in turn would bring more people to the city of Horton, and provide employment opportunities. Marcus vowed that if the city could raise 1.35 million that he would give \$150,000.
